COMES NOW ENGIE SOLAR ("ENGIE"), the winning bidder of GPA-IFB-007-18, Renewable Energy Resource Phase III (the "IFB") and requests that it be permitted to use an Italian interpreter during the hearing in this matter scheduled for March 25, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.

The testimony of these witnesses is necessary for ENGIE's case. They are both engineers. They formulated requests for information sent by ENGIE that are relevant to the issues on appeal and they participated in the formation of ENGIE's unpriced technical proposal.

ENGIE respectfully requests that the Public Auditor, pursuant to the power authorized it under 2 GAR § 12109, permit ENGIE to use an interpreter in presenting testimony by the above-described witnesses during the hearing in this matter.
