Interested Party ENGIE SOLAR ("ENGIE"), does not oppose the motion to allow remote testimony filed by Appellant GLIDEPATH MARIANAS OPERATIONS, INC. ("GlidePath") on February 20, 2020. However, ENGIE does ask that GlidePath identify what witnesses it plans to have testify remotely.

ENGIE also joins in GlidePath's motion, asking that it be allowed to present two of its witnesses via teleconference if they are unable to attend the March 25 hearing should travel restrictions be imposed on travel between Milan, Italy and Guam between now and the hearing date. ENGIE did not raise this issue previously as Italy only had 3 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Rome when motions were due on February 20. <sup>1</sup> Since the motions cutoff, the number of

confirmed cases in Italy has risen to 322.<sup>2</sup> This is an increase of 319 cases in 7 days. Most of those cases are in Milan, the city where ENGIE's witnesses reside. If travel restrictions are put in place between now and the hearing date, these witnesses may not be able to travel to Guam to provide live testimony.

ENGIE believes that it would be in its interests, and the interests of all parties who will be present at the hearing, to permit these witnesses to testify by videoconference should the need arise. Thus, ENGIE respectfully asks that they be allowed to testify remotely should they need to do so.
