

LIST OF ISSUES

1. Whether Santa Fe's breach of the purchase order contract through its

numerous deficiencies and failure to provide a suitable quarantine facility as required by

the Emergency Health Powers Act (10 GCA § 19604) justified a cancellation and

termination of the contract.

2. Whether the Procurement Law or the purchase order contract required GSA

to give Santa Fe notice of its deficiencies as a quarantine facility, together with a ten (10)

day opportunity to cure, prior to terminating the contract.
