MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES IN SUPPORT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM'S MOTION TO DISMISS APPEAL

BACKGROUND

On or about April 26, 2021, the University issued UOG-IFB-21-10 (Air Purifier System and Replacement Filters) ("IFB"), four bidders submitted bids in response to the IFB, GPE, J&B MODERN TECH, WANG BROS. HOLDING LLC., and DOCOMO, and the University conducted a bid opening on or about May 20, 2021. On or about June 7, 2021, the University determined that DOCOMO submitted the lowest responsive bid and was awarded the contract for this IFB. On or about July 1, 2021, the University prepared a Bid Status that informed GPE that its bid was rejected due to high price. Despite the preparation of these documents, they were not sent to GPE until September 2, 2021, due an oversight on the part of the University officials conducting the procurement for the IFB. On or about September 7, 2021, GPE sent, via email, its "notice of protest" to the procurement official handling the procurement of the IFB. GPE filed its appeal, In the Matter of Guam Pacific Enterprises, Inc., OPA-PA-21-006 (Office of Public Accountability), on or about September 15, 2021. See Notice of Appeal for OPA-PA-21-006 attached herein as Exhibit 1.

On or about September 23, 2021, UOG filed a Motion to Dismiss GPE's appeal in OPA-PA-21-006, alleging, in relevant part, that the OPA had no jurisdiction over the appeal due to GPE having filed it prior to UOG issuing a decision on GPE's protest. On October 4, 2021, the OPA dismissed OPA-PA-21-006 without prejudice and ordered UOG to respond to GPE's protest within fourteen (14) days of the OPA's order. At the October 4, 2021 Status Hearing in OPA-PA-21-006, it had been agreed that UOG would be using the

allegations contained in GPE's appeal in OPA-PA-21-006 as the basis of GPE's protest due to said protest merely being an email which stated that GPE was protesting, and which failed to articulate any grounds for a protest that UOG could answer. On or about October 18, 2021, UOG issued its decision denying GPE's protest. This appeal followed and GPE raised the following issues in its Notice of Appeal: (1) UOG gave GPE late notice of its award to DOCOMO; (2) Docomo's Bid did not comply with the intention and background of Exhibit A on page 20 of the IFB; (3) UOG personnel were not qualified to evaluate the bids submitted in response to the IFB; (4) UOG violated the federal Buy American Act; and (5) UOG improperly charged GPE \$25 to receive the IFB Packet. See Notice of Appeal for OPA-PA-21-011 attached herein as Exhibit 2.

ARGUMENT

The Public Auditor must dismiss the issues of whether UOG personnel were qualified to evaluate the bids submitted in response to the IFB, whether UOG violated the federal Buy American Act, and whether and UOG improperly charged GPE \$25 to receive the IFB Packet because, as will be shown below, they are not properly before the Public Auditor. The Public Auditor must dismiss the issue of whether UOG gave GPE late notice of the award of the IFB contract to DOCOMO because UOG did not violate any Procurement Laws or Regulations by doing so and because there is no remedy for such act. Finally, the OPA must strike and not consider the extraneous pleadings filed by GPE in this matter.

The issue of whether UOG Personnel were qualified to evaluate the bids submitted in response to the IFB is not Properly before the OPA.

The issue of whether UOG Personnel were qualified to evaluate the bids or draft the specifications of the IFB is not properly before the OPA because it is being raised for the first time on appeal. The jurisdiction of the OPA is limited to matters properly submitted to it. 5 G.C.A. §5703(a) and TRC Environmental Corp. v. OPA, Superior Court of Guam Special Proceedings Case No. SP0160-07, Decision and Order, p. 5 (Nov. 24, 2008). Further, a purchasing agency's procurement protest decision relative to the protest of a method of selection, solicitation, or award of a contract, may be appealed by the protestant to the Public Auditor within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the protestant of the notice of decision. 5 G.C.A. §5425(e). Thus, a protest and a protest decision are required for this matter to be properly before the Public Auditor and for the Public Auditor to have jurisdiction. Here, GPE did not raise this claim in its September 7, 2021 protest or its appeal in OPA-PA-21-006. See Notice of Appeal in OPA-PA-21-006 attached herein as Exhibit 1. As a result, there is no decision issued by UOG concerning this claim for the OPA to review. Therefore, this issue is not properly before the Public Auditor because GPE has not filed a protest with UOG concerning it and the UOG has not issued a protest decision on this issue that GPE could appeal and the OPA must dismiss it.

The issues of whether UOG violated the federal Buy American Act and whether UOG improperly charged GPE \$25 to receive the IFB Packet are not properly before the OPA.

The issues of whether UOG improperly charged GPE \$25 to receive the IFB Packet and whether UOG violated the federal Buy American Act are not properly before the OPA because GPE failed to file a timely protest concerning these issues. Generally, a protest shall be made in writing to UOG's President and shall be filed in duplicate within fourteen (14) working days after the protestor knows or should have known of the facts giving rise thereto and a protest is considered filed when received by the UOG's President. Section 9.2.3.1, University of Guam's Procurement Regulations ("UOGPR"). Protests filed after the fourteen (14) working day period shall not be considered. Id. Here, GPE filed its protest concerning these issues more than fourteen (14) working days after GPE knew or should have known of the facts giving rise thereto.

GPE filed its September 7, 2021 protest concerning the issue of whether UOG improperly charged GPE \$25 to receive the IFB Packet more than fourteen (14) working days after GPE knew or should have known of the facts giving rise to this issue. On May 4, 2021, GPE requested that UOG send it a copy of the IFB. See excerpt of Procurement Record filed in this matter attached herein as Exhibit 3 at page IFB-079. UOG responded to this request on May 4, 2021 and informed GPE that it must pay the \$25 fee to receive a copy of the IFB and that GPE must provide proof that it paid this fee prior to UOG sending GPE a copy of the IFB. Id., at IFB-082. On May 4, 2021, GPE sent UOG a second request for a copy of the IFB, and on May 5, 2021 UOG repeated that GPE must pay the \$25 fee for a copy of the IFB and UOG also provided GPE a copy of Section 3.9.6.1,

UOGPR, which authorizes UOG to charge the fee. Id., at IFB-088 and 092. GPE than sought to argue with UOG's Procurement Administrator concerning the \$25 fee and sent various emails concerning this issue on May 5, 2021 thru May 10, 2021 arguing that no other Government of Guam agency charges fees if an IFB is sent through the mail, and that there is a disagreement between GPE and UOG concerning the \$25 fee. Id., at IFB-093, 094, 097, 102, and 125. On May 11, 2021 GPE paid the \$25 fee and provided its receipt for the payment to UOG. Id., at IFB-139, 140, and 14. UOG provided GPE a copy of the IFB on that day. Id., at IFB-145. Based on this evidence, GPE knew or should of known of the facts giving rise to its issue of whether UOG was improperly charging the \$25 fee between May 4-11, 2021. Even using the last day of this period, May 11, 2021, which was a Tuesday, GPE had fourteen (14) working days from that date to file a protest concerning this issue and said time period expired on June 1, 2021. Here, GPE did not file its protest until September 7, 2021 which is beyond the fourteen (14) day period to file a protest set forth in Section 9.2.3.1, UOGPR. Accordingly, this issue is not properly before the OPA and must be dismissed.

GPE filed its September 7, 2021 protest concerning the issue of whether UOG violated the federal Buy American Act more than fourteen (14) working days after GPE knew or should have known of the facts giving rise to this issue. As stated above, GPE received the IFB on May 11, 2021. The IFB, which is part of the Procurement Record filed in this matter, is devoid of any requirement that the bidders comply with the federal Buy American Act. GPE in fact tells UOG that it must follow the Buy American Act on May 20, 2021. See email from GPE to UOG dated May 20, 2021 attached herein as

Exhibit 4. Hence, GPE knew or should have known of the issue of whether UOG was violating the federal Buy American Act on May 20, 2021. That day was a Thursday, and GPE had fourteen (14) working days from that date to file a protest concerning this issue and said time period expired on June 10, 2021. Here, GPE did not file its protest until September 7, 2021 which is beyond the fourteen (14) day period to file a protest set forth in Section 9.2.3.1, UOGPR. Accordingly, this issue is not properly before the OPA and must be dismissed.

The issue of whether UOG gave GPE late notice of the award of the IFB contract to DOCOMO is a claim for which the OPA can grant no relief.

The issue of whether UOG gave GPE late notice of the award of the IFB contract to DOCOMO is a claim for which the OPA can grant no relief. Generally, if after an award it is determined that a solicitation or award of a contract is in violation of law, and if the person awarded the contract has not acted in bad faith, then the contract award may be ratified, if doing so is in the best interests of the government, or terminated (Bold Emphasis Added). 5 G.C.A. §5452(a) and Section 9.7, UOG Procurement Regulations. The applicable law concerning notices of IFB awards states that the contract shall be awarded with reasonable promptness by written notice to the lowest responsible bidder whose bid meets the requirements and criteria set forth in the IFB, whose bid amount is sufficient to comply with the current federal wage determination applicable to Guam. 5 G.C.A. §5211(g). UOG complied with this law by providing notice of award to DOCOMO on June 8, 2021. See Exhibit 5 attached herein. Further, this law does not

state a or require a specific time in which to inform the unsuccessful bidders of the award of a contract. Therefore, as UOG did not violate 5 G.C.A. §5211(g) by giving late notice to GPE of UOG's award of the IFB contract to DOCOMO, GPE's claim concerning its receipt of the late notice, is a claim for which the OPA is not able to grant relief.

Additionally, GPE does not show how, if at all it may have been prejudiced by the late notice of UOG's award of the IFB contract to DOCOMO. GPE merely shows that it sent emails to UOG's Procurement Administrator on August 26, 2021 and August 30, 2021 following up on the status of the award. See Exhibits 3 and 4, GPE's Appeal. As a result of these follow-ups by GPE, UOG's Procurement Administrator responded on September 2, 2021 and apologized for her oversight and provided GPE notice of UOG's award of IFB contract to GPE on that day. Hence, albeit there was a delay in giving the notice of the award to GPE, UOG in fact provided it and in fact responded within a reasonable time to GPE's email inquiries. Therefore, GPE suffered no prejudice by the late notice. Accordingly, the OPA must dismiss this issue because it does not constitute a violation of procurement law and the OPA is not able to provide relief to GPE.

The OPA must strike and not consider the extraneous pleadings filed by GPE in this matter.

The OPA must strike and not consider the extraneous pleadings filed by GPE in this matter. Generally, an appellant may file a Notice of Appeal, a Comment on the Agency Report, materials required by the hearing officer for the hearings, and motions. 2 G.A.R., Division 4, Chapter 12, §12104(c)(1) and (4), and §12109(b) and (d). Here, on

October 22, 2021, GPE filed a "Reply to Protest Decision." On October 29, 2021, GPE filed a "Reply to Procurement Records Supplemental Evidence on Made in America."

Neither of these filings constitute filings permitted for an appellant under the OPA's Rules of Procedure for Procurement Appeals and are extraneous pleadings in this matter. The Hearing Officer has the authority to regulate the course of the hearing and conduct of participants therein. 2 G.A.R., Division 4, Chapter 12, §12109(e). The Hearing Officer also has the authority to Receive, rule on, exclude, or limit evidence, and limit lines of questioning or testimony which are irrelevant, immaterial, or unduly repetitious. 2 G.A.R., Division 4, Chapter 12. §12109(f). Here, the Hearing Officer must exercise this authority by striking GPE's extraneous pleadings and not consider them because they are not authorized by the OPA's Rules of Procedure and unduly prejudice UOG because the Appellant is seeking to expand the arguments and issues that he made in his Protest and his original appeal in this matter.

CONCLUSION

Based on the foregoing, the Public Auditor must dismiss the issues of whether UOG personnel were qualified to evaluate the bids submitted in response to the IFB, whether UOG violated the federal Buy American Act, whether UOG improperly charged GPE \$25 to receive the IFB Packet and the issue of whether UOG gave GPE late notice of the award of the IFB contract to DOCOMO, and strike and not consider GPE's October 22, 2021 "Reply to Protest Decision" and its October 29, 2021 "Reply to Procurement Records Supplemental

Evidence on Made in America." The OPA may then proceed with a hearing on the remaining issue of whether DOCOMO's Bid complied with the intention and background of Exhibit A on page 20 of the IFB, which GPE has stated is its main issue.

Notice of Award and Bid Status was only provided to me on Sept. 2, 2021. I had been following up since June, July and August many times but the answer was that they are still evaluating the bid.

The Administrator reasoned out that it was an oversight on her part. (Plesse see her letter dated Sept. 2 (Exhibit A) My concern or the riolation is the Notice of A ward was provided first on June 7, 2021 but the Bid Status which was not sent to me was dated July 1. (Plesse see Exhibit BandC)

The specs of Docomos offer does not comply with the intention and Background as provided in Exhibit A of the Bid (pages 20). The offer was specifically for homes not classrooms.

The offer that was favored was made in Israel not USA. UOG should be buying American made for Federal funding projects to comply with Buy American Act.

UOG violates the provisions in Instruction 12, Method of Award because the product they approved does not conform for class rooms use but only for homes. It is not in the public interest that UOG will buy or award the bid that does not served its purpose. Yes the product is cheap and the lowest bid but just a waste of money since it is not designed for schools. Plasse see page 5 of Bid Document (Method of Award.

Ruling Requested

It is up to OPA to determine the appropriate rulingor sanction to correct this wrong disposition on Method of Award and not following the basic Guam Procurement Law on Bid Status and Notice of Award. I also have to add that they (LOG) are the only one charging \$25.00 for Bid Documents in ODF file. All agencies does not charge \$25.00 if Bidders download the file.
