Please note though that 5 Guam Code Ann. §10203 may apply. In the event that the Visitors Bureau believes a thing or document need not be produced or disclosed, we will inform TLK of this, describe that thing or document, and explain why we think so.

*** Conclusion ***

The Guam Visitors Bureau has complied with the requirements of the law in this matter. If there remain things related to this procurement that TLK wishes to inspect and copy and are not otherwise protected, we will arrange a convenient time to do so.
