- A) Guam Solid Waste Authority ("GSWA"), Under the Management of Federal Receiver, Gershman, Brickner & Bratton, Inc.
- B) Invitation for Bid No. GSWA006-17; a procurement solicitation for refuse collection trucks.
- C) Decision being appealed is the GSWA Denial of Procurement Protest, dated March 3, 2017.
- D) Appeal is made from a decision on protest of method, solicitation or award.
- E) Names of competing bidders:

Mid-Pac Far East ("Mid-Pac") and Far East Equipment Company ("Far East").

Form and Filing:

1. On or about February 8, 2017, the GSWA, through its receiver Gershman, Brickner & Bratton, Inc. ("Receiver"), let the subject Invitation for Bid ("IFB"), for two categories of refuse collection trucks. The IFB is attached as **Exhibit A**.

On February 22, 2017, Morrico served a protest on the GSWA because the IFB specification for cab forward refuse trucks unlawfully restricted competition. Morrico's also protested because the Public Auditor had previously upheld Morrico's appeal of the cab forward specification as contained in GSWA001-15, finding that the specification unlawfully restricted competition. The Public Auditor's decision was upheld by a December 16, 2016, final judgment of the Superior Court of Guam. Morrico's protest is attached as **Exhibit B**.

On March 3, 2017, the GSWA denied Morrico's protest. The GSWA denied the protest based on an order of the District Court of Guam in Civil Case No. 02-00022 that authorized the Receiver to re-let the IFB for refuse trucks with a cab forward specification. The District Court's order is currently on appeal to the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals. The Receiver's protest denial letter is attached as **Exhibit C**.

- 2. Morrico requests that the Office of Public Auditor ("OPA") rule that the IFB specification restricting competition to only those vendors offering a cab forward model violates the Guam Procurement Code provisions governing specifications and that the refusal of the GSWA to amend the specifications to allow vendors to bid a conventional cab model was arbitrary, capricious and an abuse of discretion.
 - 3. Morrico has attached all supporting documents as exhibits hereto.

Declaration regarding court action:

Morrico confirms that an action in court has been commenced and that there is an appeal pending before the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals with respect to the District Court of Guam's order authorizing the Receiver to re-let the IFB with a cab forward specification.

SEALED BID SOLICITATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. BID FORMS: Each bidder shall be provided with two (2) sets of Solicitation forms. Additional copies may be provided upon request. Bidders requesting additional copies of said forms will be charged per page in accordance with 2 GAR Division 4 § 2109(f)(1) of the Government Code of Guam. All payments for this purpose shall be by cash, certified check or money order and shall be made payable to Guam Solid Waste Authority.

2. PREPARATIONS OF BIDS:

- a) Bidders are required to read and understand the specifications, schedule, and all instructions. Failure to do so will be at bidder's risk.
- b) Each bidder shall furnish the information required by the Solicitation. The bidder shall sign the solicitation and print or type his/her name on the Schedule. Erasures or other changes must be initialed by the person signing the bid. Bids signed by an agent are to be accompanied by evidence of this authority unless such evidence has been previously furnished to the issuing office.

c)Unit price for each unit offered shall be shown and such price shall include all cost delivered to GSWA unless otherwise specified.A total shall be entered in the amount column of the Schedule for each item offered.In case of discrepancies between a unit price and extended price, the unit price will be presumed to be correct.

- d) Bids for supplies or services other than those specified will not be considered. Time, if stated as a number of days, means calendar days and will include Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays beginning the day after the issuance of a Notice to Proceed. Time stated ending on Saturday, Sunday or Government of Guam legal holiday will end at the close of the next business day.
- 3. EXPLANATION TO BIDDERS: Any explanation desired by a bidder regarding the meaning or interpretation of the Solicitation, drawings, specifications, et cetera, must be submitted in writing and with sufficient time allowed for a written reply to reach all bidders before the submission of their bids. Oral explanations or instructions given before the award of the contract will not be binding. Any information given to a prospective bidder concerning a Solicitation will be furnished to all prospective bidders in writing as an amendment to the Solicitation if such information would be prejudicial to uninformed bidders.
- 4. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF AMENDMENTS TO SOLICITATIONS: Receipt of an amendment to a Solicitation by a bidder must be acknowledged by signing an acknowledgement of receipt of the amendment. Such acknowledgement must be received prior to the hour and date specified for receipt of bids.

5. SUBMISSION OF BIDS:

- a) Bids and modifications thereof shall be enclosed in sealed envelopes and addressed to the office specified in the Solicitation. The bidder shall show the hour and date specified in the Solicitation for receipt, the Solicitation number, and the name and address of the bidder on the face of the envelope.
- b) Electronic bids will not be considered unless authorized by the Solicitation. However, bids may be modified or withdrawn by written or electronic notice, provided such notice is received prior to the hour and date specified for receipt (see paragraph 6 of these instructions).
- c) Samples of items, when required, must be submitted within the time specified, unless otherwise specified by the Government, at no expense to the Government. If not destroyed by testing, samples will be returned at bidder's request and expense, unless otherwise specified by the Solicitation.
- d) Samples or descriptive literature should not be submitted unless it is required by this solicitation. Regardless of any attempt by a bidder to condition the bid, unsolicited samples or descriptive literature will not be examined or tested at the bidder's risk, and will not be deemed to vary any of the provisions of this Solicitation.
- 6. FAILURE TO SUBMIT BID: If no bid is to be submitted, do not return the solicitation documents unless otherwise specified. A letter or postcard shall be sent to the issuing office advising whether future Solicitations for the type of supplies or services covered by this Solicitation is desired.
- 7. LATE BID, LATE WITHDRAWALS, AND LATE MODIFICATIONS:
- a) Definition: Any bid received after the time and date set for receipt of bids is late. Any withdrawal or modification of a bid received after the time and date set for opening of bids at the place designated for opening is late (Guam Procurement Regulations Section 3109(k))
- b) Treatment: No late bid, late modification, or late withdrawal will be considered unless received before contract award, and the bid, modification, or withdrawal would have been timely but for the action or inaction of territorial personnel directly serving the procurement activity.

8. DISCOUNTS:

- a) Notwithstanding the fact that prompt payment discounts may be offered, such offer will not be considered in evaluating bids for award unless otherwise specified in the Solicitation. However, offered discounts will be taken if payment is made within the discount period, even though not considered in the evaluation of bids.
- b) In connection with any discount offered, time will be computed from date of delivery and acceptance of the supplies to the destination as indicated in the purchase order or contract. Payment is deemed to be made for the purpose of earning the discount on the date of mailing of the Government check.
- 9. GOVERNMENT FURNISHED PROPERTY: No material, labor or facilities will be furnished by the Government unless otherwise provided for in the Solicitation.
- 10. SELLER'S INVOICES: Invoices shall be prepared and submitted in quadruplicate (one copy shall be marked "original") unless otherwise specified. Invoices shall be "certified true and correct" and shall contain the following information: Contract and order number (if any), item numbers, description of supplies or services, sizes, quantities, unit prices, and extended total. Bill of lading number and weight of shipment will be shown for shipments made on Government bills of lading.
- 11. RECEIPT, OPENING AND RECORDING OF BIDS: Bids and modifications shall be publicly opened in the presence of one or more witnesses, at the time, date, and place designated in the Invitation for Bids. The name of each bidder, the bid price, and such other information as is deemed appropriate by the Procurement Officer, shall be read aloud and recorded, or otherwise made available. The names and addresses of required witnesses shall be recorded at the opening. The opened bids shall be available for public inspection except to the extent the bidder designates trade secrets or other proprietary data to be confidential as set forth in accordance with Section 12, below. Material so designated shall accompany the bid and shall be readily separable from the bid in order to facilitate public inspection of the non-confidential portion of the bid. Prices, makes and models or catalogue numbers of the items offered, deliveries, and terms of payment shall be publicly available at the time of bid opening regardless of any designation to the contrary (Guam Procurement Section 3109(1)2).
- 12. CONFIDENTIAL DATA: The Procurement Officer shall examine the bids to determine the validity of any requests for nondisclosure of trade secrets and other proprietary data.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SEALED BID SOLICITATION AND AWARD

- GENERAL INTENTION: Unless otherwise specified, these General Terms and conditions are intended for the bidder
 to provide the Guam Solid Waste Authority (GSWA) with specified services or with materials, supplies or equipment
 completely assembled and ready for use.
- TAXES: Bidders are cautioned that they are subject to Guam Income Taxes as well as all other taxes on Guam transactions. Specific information on taxes may be obtained from the Director of Revenue and Taxation.
- 3. LICENSING: Bidders are cautioned that GSWA will not consider for award any offer submitted by a bidder who has not complied with the Guam Licensing law. Specific information on licenses may be obtained from the Director of Revenue and Taxation.
- 4. LOCAL PROCUREMENT PREFERENCE: All procurement of supplies and services where possible, will be made from among businesses licensed to do business on Guam in accordance with section 5008 of the Guam Procurement Act (5GCA, Chapter and Section 1104 of the Guam Procurement Regulations.
- COMPLIANCE WITH SPECIFICATIONS AND OTHER SOLICITATION REQUIREMENTS: Bidders shall comply with all specifications and other requirements of the Solicitation.
- 6. NDEPENDENT PRICE DETERMINATION: The bidder, upon signing the Invitation for Bid, certifies that the prices in his bid were derived without collusion, and acknowledges that collusion and anti-competitive practices are prohibited by law. Violations will be subject to the provision of Section 5651 of that of the Guam Procurement Act. Other existing civil, criminal or administrative remedies are not impaired and may be in addition to the remedies in Section 5651 of the Government code. By submitting a bid, the bidder certifies that its price was independently arrived at without collusion.
- 7. BIDDER'S PRICE: GSWA will consider only one price per bid item by the vendor. Bidder shall explain fully each price per item. Bidder shall specify whether bid item meets all specifications or not and the product's origin. Failure to explain how the bid item does not meet the specifications is justification for disqualification of the bid.
- BID ENVELOPE: Envelope shall be sealed and marked with the Bidder's name, Bid number, time, date and place of Bid opening.
- 9. BID GUARANTEE REQUIREMENT: Bidder is required to submit a Bid Guarantee Bond or standby irrevocable Letter of Credit or Certified Check or Cashier's Check in the same bid envelope to be held by GSWA pending delivery of items being procured. The Bid Guarantee Bond, Letter of Credit, Certified Check or cashier's check must be issued by any local surety or banking institution licensed to do business on Guam and made payable to the Treasurer of Guam in the amount of fifteen percent (15%) of the total bid offer. The Bid Bond must be submitted on Government Standard Form BB-1 (copy enclosed). Personal Checks will not be accepted as Bid Guarantee. If a successful Bidder (contractor) withdraws from the bid or fails to enter into contract within the prescribed time, such Bid guarantee will be forfeited to the Government of Guam. Bids will be disqualified if not accompanied by Bid Bond, Letter of Credit, Certified Check or Cashier's Check. Bidder must include in his/her bid, valid copies of a Power of Attorney from the Surety and a Certificate of Authority from the Government of Guam to show proof that the surety company named on the bond instrument is authorized by the Government of Guam to be qualified to do business on Guam. For detailed information on bonding matters, contact the Department of Revenue and Taxation. Failure to submit a valid Power of Attorney and Certificate of Authority on the surety is cause for rejection of bid. Pursuant to 5 GCA Section 5212, all competitive sealed bidding for the procurement of supplies or services exceeding \$25,000 must be accompanied by bid security in the amount of 15% of the total bid orice.
- 10. PERFORMANCE BOND REQUIREMENT: The Bidder may be required to furnish a Performance Bond on government Standard Form BB-1 or standby irrevocable Letter of Credit or Certified Check or Cashier's Check payable to the Treasurer of Guam issued by any of the local banks or Bonding Institution in the amount equal to one hundred Percent (100%) of the contract prices as security for the faithful performance and proper fulfillment of the contract. In the event that any of the provisions of this contract are violated by the contractor, the Chief Procurement Officer shall serve a written notice upon both the contractor and the Surety of its intention to terminate the contract. Unless shall serve satisfactory arrangement or correction is made with ten (10) days of such notice the contract shall cease and terminate upon the expiration of the ten (10) days. In the event of any such termination, the Chief Procurement Officer shall immediately serve notice thereof upon the Surety. The Surety shall have the right to take over and perform the contract, provided, however, that if the Surety does not commence performance thereof within 10 days from the date of the mailing of notice of termination, the Government of Guam may take over and prosecute the same to complete the contract or force account for the account and at the expense of the contractor, and the contractor and his Surety shall be liable to the Government for any excess cost occasioned the Government thereby.

- 11. PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE: Bidders, who are awarded a contract under this solicitation, guarantee that goods will be delivered or required services performed within the time specified. Failure to perform the contract in a satisfactory manner may be cause for suspension or debarment from doing business with the Government and for enforcement of Section 23 of these General terms and Conditions. In addition, the Government will hold the Vendor liable and will enforce the requirements as set forth in Section 41 of these General Terms and Conditions.
- 12. SURETY BONDS: Bid and Performance Bonds coverage must be signed or countersigned in Guam by a foreign or alien surety's resident general agent. The Surety must be an Insurance Company, authorized by the Government of Guam and qualified to do business in Guam. Bids will be disqualified if the Surety Company does not have a valid Certificate of Authority from the Government of Guam to conduct business in Guam.
- 13. COMPETENCY OF BIDDERS: Bids will be considered only from such bidders who, in the opinion of the Government, can show evidence of their ability, experience, equipment, and facilities to render satisfactory service.
- 14. DETERMINATION OF RESPONSIBILITY OF BIDDERS: The GSWA Receiver reserves the right for securing from bidders information to determine whether or not they are responsible and to inspect plant site, place of business; and supplies and services as necessary to determine their responsibility in accordance with Section 15 of these General Terms and Conditions (GPR Section 3116).
- 15. STANDARD FOR DETERMINATION OF LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER: In determining the lowest responsible offer, the Guam Solid Waste Authority Receiver shall be guided by the following:
 - a) Price of items offered.
 - b) The ability, capacity, and skill of the Bidder to perform.
 - c) Whether the bidder can perform promptly within the specified time.
 - d) The quality of performance of the Bidder with regards to awards previously made to him.
 - e) The previous and existing compliance by the Bidder with laws and regulations relative to procurement.
 - f) The sufficiency of the financial resources and ability of the Bidder to perform.
 - g) The ability of the bidder to provide future maintenance and services for the subject of the award.
 - h) The compliance with all of the conditions to the Solicitation.
- 16. TIE BIDS: If the bids are for the same unit price or total amount in the whole or in part, the GSWA-Receiver will determine award based on Section 3109(0)(2), or to reject all such bids (GPR Section 3109(0)(2)).
- 17. BRAND NAMES: Any reference in the Solicitation to manufacturer's Brand Names and number is due to lack of a satisfactory specification of commodity description. Such preference is intended to be descriptive, but not restrictive and for the sole purpose of indicating to prospective bidders a description of the article or services that will be satisfactory. Bids on comparable items will be considered provided the bidder clearly states in his bid the exact articles he is offering and how it differs from the original specification.
- 18. DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE: Descriptive literature(s) as specified in this solicitation must be furnished as a part of the bid and must be received at the date and time set for the opening Bids. The literature furnished must clearly identify the item(s) in the Bid. The descriptive literature is required to establish for the purpose of evaluation and award details of the product(s) the bidder proposes to furnish including design, materials, components, performance characteristics, methods of manufacture, construction, assembly or other characteristics which are considered appropriate. Rejection of the Bid will be required if the descriptive literature(s) do not show that the product(s) offered conform(s) to the specifications and other requirements of this solicitation. Failure to furnish the descriptive literature(s) by the time specified in the Solicitation will require rejection of the bid.
- 19. AWARD, CANCELLATION, & REJECTION: Award shall be made to the lowest responsible bidder, whose bid is determined to be the most advantageous to the GSWA, taking into consideration the evaluation factors set forth in this solicitation. No other factors or criteria shall be used in the evaluation. GSWA reserves the right to waive any minor irregularity in bid received. The Guam Solid Waste Authority Receiver shall have the authority to award, cancel, or reject bids, in whole or in part for any one or more items if he determines it is in the public interest. In case of an error in the extension of prices, unit price will govern. It is the policy of the Government to award contracts to qualified local bidders. The Government reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity of the items for award and make additional awards for the same type of items and the vendor agrees to such modifications and additional awards based on the bid prices for a period of thirty (30) days after original award.
- 20. SCHEDULE FOR DELIVERY: Successful bidder shall notify GSWA Receivership, by email to the GSWA's procurement agent at least twenty-four (24) hours before delivery of any item under this solicitation.
- 21. BILL OF SALE: Successful supplier shall render Bills of Sale for each item delivered under this contract. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in rejection of delivery. The Bill of Sale must accompany the items delivered but will not be considered as an invoice for payment. Supplier shall bill the GSWA in accordance with billing instructions as indicated on the Purchase Order.
- 22. MANUFACTURER'S CERTIFICATE: Successful bidder is required, upon delivery of any item under this solicitation, to furnish a certificate from the manufacturer indicating that the goods meet the specifications. Failure to comply with this request will result in rejection of delivery or payment. Supplier shall bill the Government in accordance with billing instructions as indicated on the PurchaseOrder.
- 23. NSPECTION: All supplies, materials, equipment, or services delivered under this contract shall be subject to the inspection and/or test conducted by the GSWA at destination. If in any case the supplies, materials, equipment, or services are found to be defective in material, workmanship, performance, or otherwise do not conform with specifications, the GSWA shall have the right to reject the items or require that they be corrected. The number of days required for correction will be determined by the GSWA.
- 24. SAFETY NSPECTIONS: All motor vehicles delivered under this contract must pass the Government of Guam Vehicle Inspection before delivery at destination.

25. GUARANTEE:

a) Guarantee of Vehicle Type of Equipment

The successful bidder shall guarantee vehicular type of equipment offered against defective parts, workmanship, and performance, for a period of not less than one (1) year after date of receipt of equipment. Bidder shall also provide service to the equipment for at least one (1) year. Service to be provided shall include, but will not be limited to tune ups (change of spark plugs, contact points and condensers) and lubrication (change of engine and transmission oil). All parts and labor shall be at the expense of the bidder. All parts found defective and not caused by misuse, negligence or accident within the guarantee period shall be repaired, replaced, or adjusted within six (6) working days after notice from the GSWA and without cost to the GSWA. Vehicular type of equipment as used in this context shall include equipment used for transportation as differentiated from tractors, backhoes, etc.

b) Guarantee of Other Type of Equipment:

The successful bidder shall guarantee all other types of equipment offered, except those mentioned in 24a, above, against defective parts, workmanship, and performance for a period of not less than three (3) months after date of receipt of equipment. Bidder shall also provide service to the equipment for at least three (3) months. All parts found within that period shall be repaired or replaced by the Contractor without cost to the GSWA. Repairs, adjustments or replacements of defective parts shall be completed by the contractor within six (6) working days after notice from the GSWA.

- c) Compliance with this Section is a condition of this Bid.
- 26. This office represents Morrico Equipment, LLC ("Morrico"), 197 Ypao Road, Tamuning, Guam 96913, with respect to GSWA006-17, a procurement solicitation for refuse collection trucks.

Morrico hereby files its protest with respect to the above-referenced procurement. These are the same trucks solicited in GSWA001-15, which Morrico protested based on the cab forward specification. The Public Auditor ruled that the cab forward specification unlawfully restricted competition. After the GSWA sued for judicial review, the Superior Court of Guam entered a December 16, 2016, final judgment upholding the Public Auditor's determination and ordering the GSWA to allow the bid of conventional cab refuse trucks.

Morrico protests the above procurement based on all of the reasons advanced in Morrico's prior protest letter of October 9, 2014, submitted in GSWA001-15 which it hereby incorporates by reference, and based on the determinations of the Public Auditor and the Superior Court of Guam with respect to that prior protest.

This letter is in response to your protest letter dated February 22, 2017, on behalf of your client Morrico Equipment, LLC ("Morrico"). The Guam Solid Waste Authority (GSWA) is currently under the authority of the Federal Receiver appointed by the District Court of Guam in Civil Case No. 02-0022 United States of America v. Government of Guam. In its Order dated March 17, 2008, the District Court appointed the Receiver specifying the following: "the Receiver shall have the authority required or necessary for the complete management and control of the Consent Decree projects, including but not limited to: ... (c) The entering into future contracts deemed necessary. In awarding any future contracts, the Receiver shall follow the procedures required in Guam's statues and regulations, unless, in the best judgment of the Receiver, such compliance would unreasonably delay the progress in meeting the mandates of the Consent Decree".

Under the financing plan approved by the District Court, these trucks are vital to GSWA revenue needed to pay for the remaining Consent Decree obligations. In its Order dated February 27, 2017, the District Court affirmed the authority of the Receiver discussed above as well as the Receiver's use of that authority in this matter. The Court ordered the Receiver to issue a new procurement for cab forward refuse collection trucks. This is the procurement Morrico now protests. To uphold Morrico's protest would violate the clear mandate of the District Court's Order. For this reason, the protest is denied.

This decision is final and not subject to further review by officials of the Government of Guam.
