OPPOSITION TO DPW'S MOTION TO DISMISS; JOINDER IN DPW'S MOTION FOR EXPEDITED DECISION

Appellant Core Tech International Corp. ("Core Tech") hereby opposes Department of Public Works' ("DPW") Motion to Dismiss and joins in DPW's Motion for Expedited Decision in this matter, both filed on March 31, 2017.

In its Motion to Dismiss, DPW claims that there is no remaining dispute in this Appeal because it has conceded in its Agency Report that DPW will limit the RFP to the services and work relating to the Simon Sanchez High School Project and to the preparation of the CCIP. *See, Motion to Dismiss* at 2. Core Tech disagrees with DPW on this point: DPW's concession in its Agency Report does not resolve all of the issues.

As discussed in Core Tech's Response to Agency Report filed concurrently, a full resolution of Core Tech's appeal requires a determination by the Public Auditor that:

- 1. The procurement of insurance and maintenance of the remaining 34 schools is not authorized under Chapter 58E. The current RFP should not include procurement of services and work for 5 GCA Chapter 58E, and cannot be used to expand the services and work authorized.
- 2. Chapter 58E103 requires the Program Study to be completed at least 30 days before the issuance of the RFP for procurement of work and services for the 34 remaining schools.

Core Tech joins in DPW's request for an expedited decision.
