THIS MATTER, came before the Hearing Officer pursuant to the Appellant's (Hereafter referred to as "CTI") Motion for Sanctions against the Purchasing Agency (Hereafter Referred to as "DPW") for failure to file and timely serve a timely and complete procurement record filed in this matter on November 20, 2017.

BACKGROUND

DPW filed the procurement record in this matter on October 31, 2017, a Supplement to the Procurement Record on November 3, 2017, and a Supplement to the Procurement Record dated

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November 13, 2017. As a result of these filings, the OPA has received from DPW the following batches of records: (1) Box A; (2) Box B; (3) Box D; (4) Documents K1-K9; (5) Documents AL1-AL11; (6) Documents I thru IV; (7) A CD labled "FOIA Request David Yao;" (8) A CD labled "FOIA Request Mike Hobbs;" (9) A CD labled "FOIA Request David Titzel;" (10) Two CDs labled Plans and Specs and Non-Compliance Report; (11) A sealed envelope containing priviliged communications; and (12) A CD titled "F-82 and F-82AG Checklist."

It its motion and reply brief, CTI claims that it only received item numbers 7, 8, 9, and 12, described above, in the form of four CDs. In its opposition brief DPW claims that it has provided the entire procurement record to CTI.

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DISCUSSION

After reviewing copies of the four CDs that DPW provided to CTI, the Hearing Officer finds that CTI has not received the complete procurement record that DPW filed with the OPA. DPW was required to provide the OPA a complete copy of the procurement record by October 31, 2017. 2 G.A.R., Div. 4, Chap. 12, §12104(3) and Notice of Receipt of Appeal filed on October 24, 2017. Additionally, on November 8, 2017, the Hearing Officer ordered DPW to provide CIT's counsel a copy of the Procurement Record in this matter. However, it is clear that DPW only provided CTI's counsel item 7, which is the CD labled "FOIA Request David Yao," item 8, which is the CD labled "FOIA Request Mike Hobbs," item (9), which is the CD labled "FOIA Request David Titzel," and item 12, which is the CD titled "F-82 and F-82AG Checklist." DPW claims that it served the remaining documents, which it placed on a CD, to CTI's counsel, however it could not produce a stamp receipt from CTI's counsel's office confirming this. See page 2, DPW's Opposition filed on December 6, 2017 (Hereafter Referred to as "Opposition"). CTI's counsel denies this claim. The Hearing Officer finds that without the stamp receipt from CTI's counsel's office, DPW's claim that they served the CD is less credible than the CTI's statement that it did not receive the CD. Hence, the Hearing Officer finds that DPW failed to deliver the remaining documents from the procurement record to CTI's counsel. DPW also alleges that as a result of various Freedom of Information Act (Hereafter referred to as "FOIA")

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requests made by CTI, that its responses to the FOIA requests serve as its delivery of the procurement record to CTI. Page 2, Opposition. The Hearing Officer disagrees with this argument for two reasons. First, the FOIA requests are a separate matter and not a part of these proceedings. Second, without being provided with a complete copy of the procurement record in this matter, CTI has no way knowing whether the documents provided in response to the FOIA requests constitute a complete procurement record.

Finally, the Hearing Officer reviewed the four CDs provided by DPW to CTI to determine whether they contained a complete procurement record. After an extensive review, the Hearing Officer finds that item (8), which is the CD labled "FOIA Request Mike Hobbs," and item (9), which is the CD labled "FOIA Request David Titzel," contain some material from Box A. Further item (7) item 7, which is the CD labled "FOIA Request David Yao," contains some material from Box A and Box B. However, none of these CDs, or all of them combined contain all the material in Box A or Box B, and none of these CDs contain any plans or specifications. Hence, the Hearing Officer finds that DPW failed to provide CTI with a complete procurement record.

As a sanction, CTI requests that DPW be prevented from introducing any evidence in support of its defenses in this matter. See CTI's reply brief, page 5. DPW is reminded that the Hearing Officer may sanction a non-compliant party by refusing to allow a party to support or oppose designated claims or defenses, and may prohibit a party from introducing designated matters into evidence. 2 G.A.R., Div. 4, Chap. 12, §12109(h). However, the Hearing Officer will not impose such sanctions at this time.

The Hearing Re Appellant's Appeal scheduled for 10:00 a.m., on December 13, 2017 is hereby VACATED, however, the parties must still appear at that date and time for a scheduling conference. DPW is hereby ORDERED to provide a complete procurement record,

excluding items 7, 8, 9, and 12, described above, to CTI no later than 5:00 p.m., on December 20, 2017, and must include a log of its privileged materials in lieu of said materials. A new scheduling order will be issued concerning extended filing deadlines for amended hearing materials.
