Statement of Findings

- 1. 4 GCA 4 GCA §4301(a) authorizes I Maga'lahi (the Governor) to enter contracts and reject proposals, with one (1) or more insurance companies, authorized to do business in Guam, for group insurance, including, but not limited to, hospitalization, medical care, life, and accident, for all employees or separate groups of employees, and foster children, of the government of Guam.
- 2. 4 GCA 4 GCA §4301(c) authorizes a Negotiating Team to examine the financial information of the prepaid health insurance companies, health care providers or other legal entities for the purpose of developing the most economical and beneficial health plan for the government of Guam employees and retirees, and foster children.
- 3. The government of Guam acquires group health insurance each fiscal year.
- 4. The administration of health insurance coverage is a complicated and specialized business field as there are risk factors that are better handled by industry professionals in the insurance business.
- 5. The government of Guam requested if such personnel were available to perform the requested services. The government has determined that such personnel does not have the expertise, professional personnel or reinsurers to provide health insurance coverage.
- 6. The nature of the relationship to be established between the Government and the insurance company will be as a business contractual arrangement where premiums will be remitted in exchange for covered services for medical, vision and dental insurance pursuant to the terms of the contract.

7. The government has developed a draft contract to be attached to the Request for Proposal that will outline how services are to be utilized, subject to negotiations. The government fully intends to implement the written contractual plan for utilizing such services which will be included in the contractual statement of work once negotiations have been completed.

Conclusions

- The Department of Administration determines that the need to procure the services of qualified health insurance company (ies) is in the best interest of the government of Guam.
- 2. The Department of Administration determines that by procuring qualified health insurance company (ies), the government of Guam will be ensuring that its employees, retirees, survivors, and foster children under the legal custody of the Child Protective Services Division of the Department of Public Health and Social Services are insured for quality healthcare coverage.

Hi Leonora,

It was nice to see you yesterday. I was reminded of the work we did before my retirement representing the healthcare negotiating team; this was always very satisfying work.

So, despite what I may have said yesterday, I would enjoy working on that team as a representative (as opposed to working for the team as its lawyer).

If the governor chose to appoint me, I would serve gladly. Please remember that I already turned her down for the ethics commission;so, if she is hesitant to invest time in appointing me, feel free to tell your contact person that you have spoken to me and I am agreeable.

As to the question of coverage under the Selectcare contract for retirees who have Medicare A and B, and for which medicare is their primary insurance (as federal law requires), see email below.

Section 5.17 of the Certificate says, in part:


"For Covered Person enrolled in Medicare Parts A and B and where Medicare is primary, Company shall pay the copayments, deductibles, and co-insurance required by Medicare and treat Covered Person as having met the Out-of-Pocket maximun under the plan for purpose of receiving benefits under this Agreement."

Like I said, pretty clear for lawyer-speak. Even I and my local insurance agent can understand this. Also, as far as I have been able to discern, there is nothing in the contract or certificate that contradicts or minimizes the effect of this provision.

I agree with you that Aon should audit the insurers, specifically as it applies to retirees with Medicare A and B, and especially those covered under the 2000 program, as to whether this provision is being followed. I cannot speak to whether those in the 1500 program are treated the same as myself, but providers seem to suggest that there is a different approach for those in the 1500 program.

I will meet with a Selectcare representative, likely tomorrow, as to my own issue (an October m.d. visit, covered by Medicare, and for which Selectcare has denied the request of my provider to pay \$115, presumably part of my 'deductible') and keep you apprised.





The direction is to negotiate and procure the most economical proposal for all government employees. There is no separate provision for individual units to adopt differential rates for agencies other than certain agencies prescribed in statute. Indeed, such a process may prove to be the detriment of the Government as a whole. You may recall that the Public Auditor had recommended that health insurance rates be blended to achieve savings, not disaggregated.

With respect to your request to attend the team meetings as an observer. The team has adopted procedures designed to preserve the confidentiality essential to this and other procurement negotiations. "...all health insurance companies or health care providers contracted to provide health care to government of Guam employees and retirees shall provide the negotiating team...and the Office of Finance and Budget fifteen (15) months of detailed claims utilization and cost information from period October 1 to September 30 of the previous fiscal year, and October 1 to December 31 of the current fiscal year, no later than March 1 for the final updated data for the previous fiscal year in electronic database file format such as Microsoft Access or Microsoft Excel."

The detailed claims utilization and cost information requested only includes de-identified health information as permitted under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) and does not include any protected health information as defined in such act. Additionally, for billing purposes, health insurance claims systems are designed to track information at the subgroup level, so the parsing of this information is possible. If the current information in your possession can't segregate GWA employee and retiree data, then can you request the information be segregated in the FY 2020 Invitation to Bid which is authorized in 4GCA § 4302(g)(4)(E)?





Buenas! On or about February 28, 2019, the Judicial Branch sent notice of its intent, at that time, to enter into a separate contract for group health insurance pursuant to 4 GCA §4301(c). Since that time, Public Law 35-2 was signed into law requiring consideration of only those companies or entities providing Health Insurance to the Government of Guam whose in-network coverage includes all public and private hospitals operating in Guam. The passage of Public Law 35-2 now requires that the Judicial Branch withdraw its notice of intent to enter into a separate contract for group insurance, given the uncertainty of those companies or entities that will be able to contract for the health insurance needs of the employees of the Judicial Branch. As such, the Judicial Branch retains all rights under 4 GCA §§4301-4308.
