21 **THIS MATTER** came before the Hearing Officer on February 3, 2012 for a hearing on
22 the Purchasing Agency's Motion to Dismiss for Failure to State Grounds for Appeal . The
23 Appellant was represented by Ravindra B. Gogineni who appeared *Pro Se*. Marcus Y. Pido,
24 Guam Department of Education (Hereafter Referred to as "DOE"), Supply Management
25 Administrator, was present and represented by DOE's Legal Counsel, Rebecca M. Perez, Esq.
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1 **BACKGROUND**

2 On December 14, 2011, Appellant filed the Notice of Appeal in this matter and attached a
3 two (2) page untitled statement to said notice. Appellants statement described, in relevant part,
4 DOE's issuance of GDOE-IFB-035-2011, GDOE-IFB-036-2011, GDOE-IFB-037-2011, GDOE-
5 IFB-038-2011, and GDOE-IFB-039-2011 (Structural Repairs & Roof Coating for Various
6 Schools) (Hereafter Referred to as "IFBs"), Appellant's protests concerning these solicitations,
7 Appellant's allegation that DOE's solicitation process for the IFBs was not fair and lacked
8 critical information to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, and Appellant's
9 six (6) reasons Appellant claims to support the aforementioned allegation.¹ On December 19,
10 2011, DOE filed its motion to dismiss this matter for Appellant's failure to state grounds for
11 appeal alleging that Appellant failed to include a statement of the grounds for its appeal in
12 Appellant's Notice of Appeal, as required by 2 G.A.R., Div. 4, Chap. 12, §12104.² On January
13 6, 2012, Appellant filed its Comments on the Agency Report and argued that the two (2) page
14 statement, described above, attached to its Notice of Appeal was the statement required by the
15 aforementioned procurement regulation.³

16 **DISCUSSION**

17 The Appellant was required to submit the statement as alleged by DOE. Generally, an
18 appellant's notice of appeal shall contain a concise, logically arranged, and direct statement of
19 the grounds of their appeals. 2 G.A.R., Div. 4, Chap. 12, §12104(b)(2). Further, an appellant's


1 failure to submit such a statement may result in dismissal of an appeal. 2 G.A.R., Div. 4, Chap.
2 12, §12104(b)(7). Here, the Hearing Officer's analysis now turns to whether the two (2) page
3 untitled statement attached to the Appellant Notice of Appeal is the statement of the grounds for
4 appeal required by 2 G.A.R., Div. 4, Chap. 12, §12104(b)(2).
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6 The Appellant's statement constitutes a valid statement of the grounds for this appeal.
7 Specifically, as stated above, the statement which is concise, as it is only two (2) pages, and
8 logically arranged, details Appellant's general allegation that the DOE's solicitation of DOE's
9 solicitation process for the IFBs was not fair and lacked critical information to determine the
10 lowest responsive and responsible bidder, and six (6) reasons Appellant claims support the
11 aforementioned general allegation. Thus, the Hearing Officer finds that the Appellant's
12 statement, although untitled, but which contained a concise, logically arranged, and direct
13 statement of the grounds for Appellant's appeal, complies with 2 G.A.R., Div. 4, Chap. 12,
14 §12104(b)(2).
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17 CONCLUSION

18 Based on the foregoing, DOE's Motion to Dismiss for Failure to State Grounds for
19 Appeal is hereby DENIED.
