

5. GCC's obligations under this stipulation are fulfilled once GCC issues the new IFB for typhoon shutter installation. If a party protests prior to award or any unforeseen circumstances arise after GCC issues the new IFB, which postpone evaluation or granting an award to a bidder, those circumstances do not trigger the restoration of the parties respective rights and remedies prior to settlement.
6. Eons agrees to dismiss this appeal without prejudice upon approval of the Hearing Officer.
7. The parties agree that this is a full and final settlement of all the issues arising out of the typhoon shutter installation IFB.
8. All parties agree to vacate all the dates on the scheduling order.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree and request the Office of Public Accountability dismiss without prejudice the above captioned appeal.
