28 b) Possibility of obtaining admissions of fact and of documents that will avoid

1 unnecessary proof, stipulations regarding the authenticity of documents, and advance rulings
2 from the Hearing Officer on the admissibility of evidence;

3 c) The avoidance of unnecessary proof and of cumulative evidence;

4 d) The identification of witnesses and documents, the need and schedule for filing
5 and exchanging pretrial briefs;

6 e) The disposition of pending motions;

7 f) The need for adopting special procedures for managing potentially difficult or
8 protracted actions, complex issues, multiple parties, or unusual proof problems;

9 g) Establishing a reasonable limit on the time allowed for presenting evidence; and

10 h) Such other matters as may facilitate the just, speedy, and inexpensive disposition
11 of the action.

12 2. For February 3, 2011 Motion Hearing, if any motions are filed, the parties shall
13 comply with the following filing schedule:

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
