

1 b) Possibility of obtaining admissions of fact and of documents that will avoid
2 unnecessary proof, stipulations regarding the authenticity of documents, and advance rulings
3 from the Hearing Officer on the admissibility of evidence;

4 c) The avoidance of unnecessary proof and of cumulative evidence;

5 d) The identification of witnesses and documents, the need and schedule for filing
6 and exchanging pretrial briefs;

7 e) The disposition of pending motions;

8 f) The need for adopting special procedures for managing potentially difficult or
9 protracted actions, complex issues, multiple parties, or unusual proof problems;

10 g) Establishing a reasonable limit on the time allowed for presenting evidence; and

11 h) Such other matters as may facilitate the just, speedy, and inexpensive disposition
12 of the action.

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
