The General Services Agency, in conjunction with the Office of the Attorney General, has advised Appellant that it has withdrawn the solicitation known as "Invitation To Bid GSA-010-09" pursuant to 2 GAR Div. 4 §3115 (d). The General Services Agency does not intend to pursue the solicitation of the goods and services identified in "Invitation To Bid GSA-010-09" until such time as the Public Auditor renders a decision in this Appeal. 
