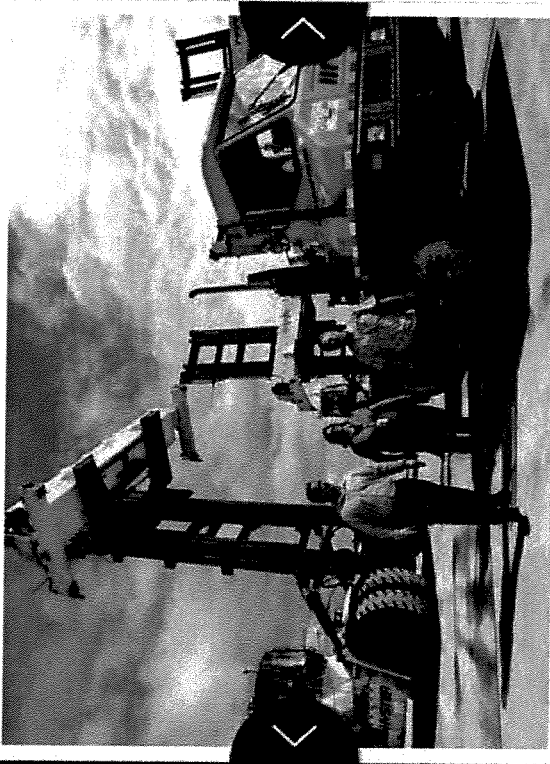

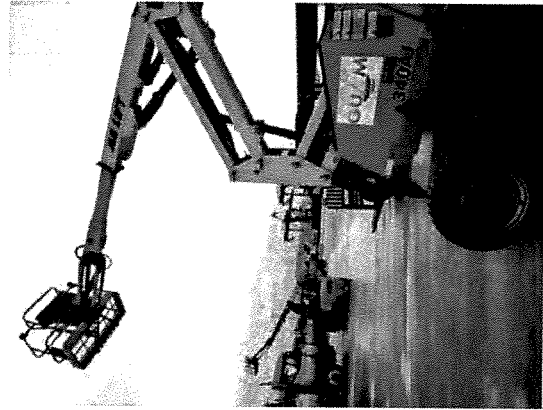

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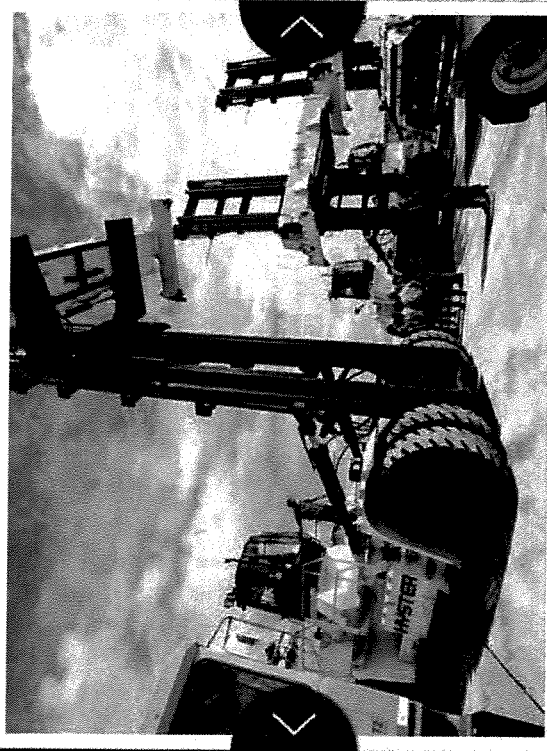

The Port received: 16 tractors; four 40-ton top lifters; four five-ton forklifts; two man lifts with 126-feet and 40-feet reach; two welding machines and a street sweeper.

The Port also expects to receive two more forklifts in April.

Former Port board chairman and a long-time employee Frank Santos said when he started working at the Port in the 1970s, there wasn't a lot of equipment.

"Take a look at us now. Behind us, we can move any kind of cargo that is coming into the port," he said. "We should be proud of this beautiful world-class port in this part of the world."

General Manager Joanne Brown said it's a major step for the Port, after going months trying to manage operations with limited equipment. At one point, the Port was tracking its equipment on an hourly basis, she said.

She thanked the Port employees who helped maintain and keep things together during those months.

"It's not the type of operation we want, and certainly, moving forward, it's not the type of operation we will have," Brown said. "At the end of the day, having equipment when we need it is very important," she said.

The new equipment will give the Port a reserve capacity and will help the Port as it refurbishes old equipment, she said.

If equipment breaks, the Port can use a replacement to keep operations going smoothly.

"We've come a long way," Brown said.

The Port has close to \$48 million in annual revenue, and Brown said a percentage is being set aside to replace equipment and prevent a future crisis.

New year, new gear: Port Authority rolls out \$5M of equipment

In a time when it's experiencing unprecedented growth, the Port Authority of Guam hit another major milestone today as it unveiled more than \$5 million worth of new equipment with more to come well into the New Year.

"We should stand high, and we must be proud, because our port now becomes one of the world class ports in this part of the world," said former port chairman Francisco Santos. And with decades of experience working at the agency, Santos says the port has come a very long way. "I remember way back in the 70s when I first worked at the port authority in 1974, we only had one gantry old beat up gantry number one. We had two straddle hoist, three TCMs (transport cargo mobile), two stick cranes that operating the port at that time, and now look at us!" he shared.

Today before island leaders and the real VIPs - the hardworking employees, Port Authority management unveiled essential equipment set to enhance port operations and service capabilities. As part of the new equipment inventory include 16 new tractors, four 40-ton top lifters, four 5-ton forklifts, two man lifts, two welding machines, and one street sweeper.

General manager Joanne Brown said, "We're looking at close to \$5.5 million worth of equipment...the only thing that's missing is we have another 10- and 20-ton that's

arriving within the next month, in addition to that a major step forward for us and the port. Because I came into a situation where essentially we were living not feast to famine but famine to famine and we essentially were sometimes keeping track of the equipment on an hourly basis. There were times when we had our vessels in and we were down to zero toplifters and that's not the way to operate."

The port is also building toward a reserve capacity as the existing equipment will also be refurbished. And while these new equipment is definitely a welcome addition, it actually only represents less than 45 percent of new acquired equipment the port expects in the next year to fill up its extended yard. Brown said, "At the end of the day we have very important mission and this is our key role of what we do here of moving cargo and having equipment available when we need it, is very important."

Statement of Reasons for Protest:

MPFE hereby protests Invitation for Bid No. GSA/PAG-025-17 on the basis that the body color designated in the bid unfairly restricts competition on the bid.

The body color designated in Invitation for Bid No. GSA/PAG-025-17 is "Main Body Safety Yellow and Black trimming". Only certain manufacturers produce equipment that meet the other specification listed in Invitation for Bid No. GSA/PAG-025-17 and produce said equipment with a "Main Body Safety Yellow and Black trimming" color.

MPFE asked that said specification be removed through a letter dated September 26, 2017. The General Services Agency (GSA) responded on October 4, 2017, stating that it would not remove the specification. It should be noted that not reason was given for why the color specification should remain. Further, MPFE takes note that the Port Authority of Guam currently uses equipment that is painted yellow, orange, and green. Newspaper articles are attached showing various equipment that is orange in color. Further, the gantry cranes at the Port Authority of Guam are all painted green. There does not seem to be any reason to limit bidders to a "Main Body Safety Yellow and Black trimming" designation.

By limiting bidders to parties that can deliver equipment that meets the "Main Body Safety Yellow and Black trimming" color specification, the General Services Agency is limiting the number of prospective bidders. This is particularly troubling given that no reason has been stated for specifying that color and the fact that the Port Authority of Guam currently uses equipment that does not meet the "Main Body Safety Yellow and Black trimming" color specification.

Supporting Documents

Attached is a letter sent from MPFE to Claudia Acfalle, dated September 26, 2017 whereby MPFE asked GSA to remove the color specification. Also attached is a "Response to Questions", dated October 4, 2017, whereby GSA noted that it would not remove the color specification. Lastly, newspaper articles, printed from news websites are attached, showing other port equipment that does not meet the "Main Body Safety Yellow and Black trimming" color specification.

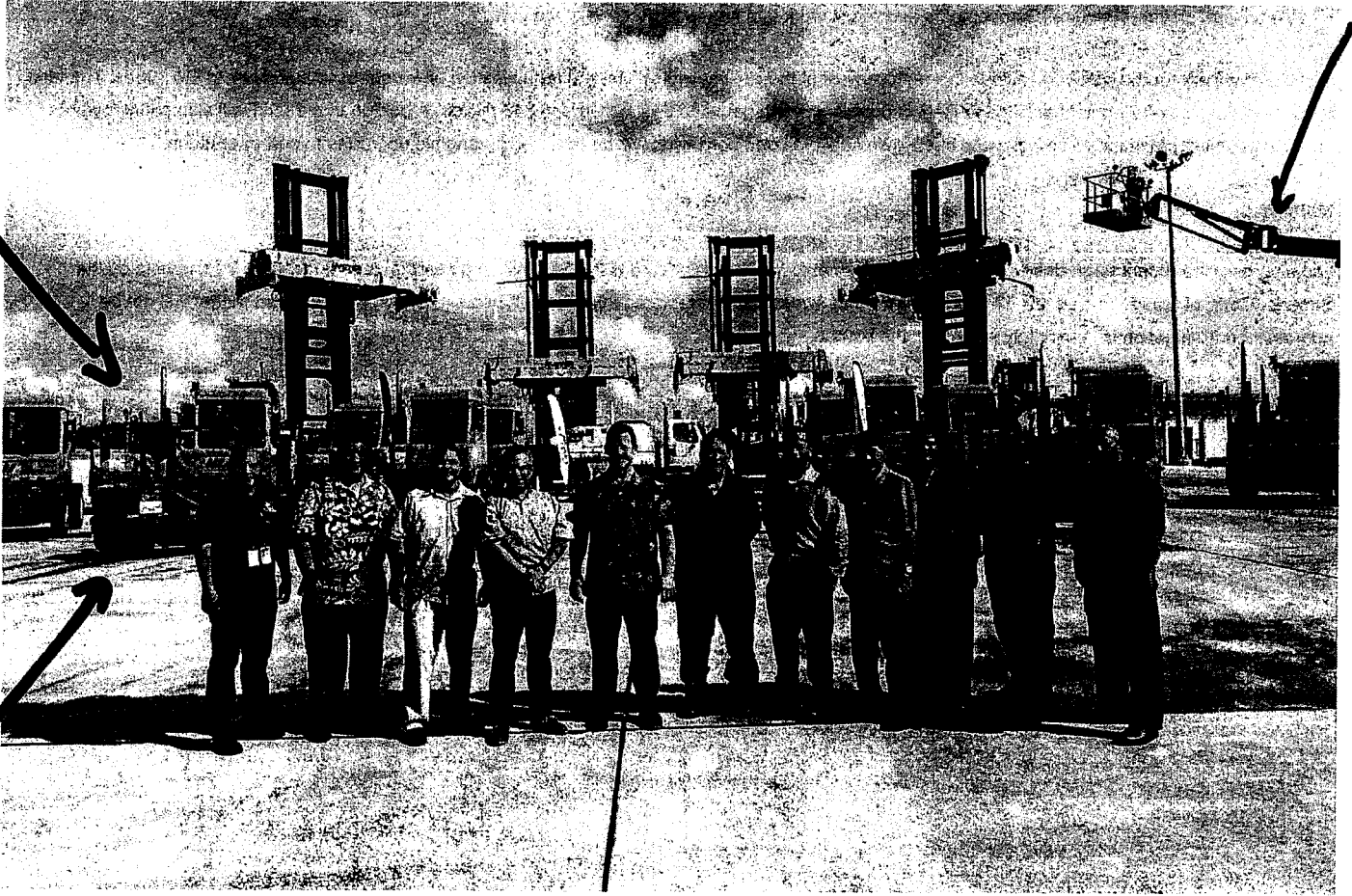

Port purchases \$5.5M worth of new assets

Employees at the Port Authority of Guam will have over \$5 million in new equipment to work with thanks to a couple loans and increasing operational revenue. The equipment – a total of 29 items comprised of top lifters, forklifts, tractors and other machines – were purchased through a \$2 million Bank of Guam Loan, a \$2 million U.S. Department of Agriculture Direct Loan and over \$1.5 million in port funds.

The new equipment will relieve aging port assets, assist in maintaining reserves with the refurbishment of older equipment and help port management continue operations without having to live "famine to famine," as port General Manager Joanne Brown recalled of the situation at the port in the past.

"Sometimes when we had a vessel in, we couldn't discharge cargo because we had no top lifters to assist our truckers," Brown said. "That's not the kind of operation we want, and certainly moving forward that's not the kind of operation we can count on."

The port is closing in on becoming a \$48 million operation per year in terms of revenue, Brown added.

Looking ahead

In addition to the equipment available now, the port will be receiving two more forklifts in April. The new assets will join several other improvement projects planned for the port, such as the procurement of a new gantry crane to replace Gantry 3, which was retired last year after about 30 years of service.


