THIS MATTER, came before the Public Auditor on December 11, 2017 pursuant to the Appellant's (Hereafter Referred to as "CTI") Motion for Leave to File a Motion for Partial Summary Judgement that was filed in this matter on November 14, 2017. After reviewing the aforementioned motion and after reviewing the briefs and arguments of the parties concerning the same, the Public Auditor, hereby FINDS and ORDERS the following

1. The Public Auditor finds that this motion is now moot. Generally, a claim is moot when issues no longer live or the parties lack a legally cognizable legal interest in the outcome. In Re Guardianship of Ulloa, 2014 Guam 32, ¶25. Accordingly, an issue should be dismissed as moot

when, by virtue of an intervening event, the appellate tribunal cannot grant effective relief whatever in favor of the appellant. Id. Further, a case can become moot at any stage of litigation. Id., at ¶26. Here, the original motion filing deadline in this matter was set for November 6, 2017 and this date was chosen so that the Office of Public Accountability (OPA) could receive, hear, and decide any motions of the parties in a timely manner prior to hearing for the Appellant's Appeal that was originally scheduled for December 13, 2017. However, on December 11, 2017, the OPA partially granted, in relevant part, the Appellant's Motion for Sanctions by finding that the Purchasing Agency failed to provide the Appellant a complete copy of the procurement record in this matter and vacated the December 13, 2017 hearing and ordered the Purchasing Agency to provide a complete procurement record to the Appellant by December 20, 2017 and rescheduling the hearing to February 6, 2018. Further, on January 25, 2018, the OPA granted the Purchasing Agency's Motion to Continue the formal hearing. Hence, the Appellant's Motion is now moot because due to the Purchasing Agency not providing the Appellant a complete procurement record as ordered, a new motion deadline will have to be scheduled in this matter, as well as a new hearing for the Appellant's Appeal will be scheduled.

2. Based on the foregoing, the Appellant's Motion for Leave to File Motion for Partial Summary Judgement is hereby DENIED because it is moot. The OPA shall issue an amended Scheduling Order that includes a new motion filing deadline.
