COMMENTS ON AGENCY REPORT


Comes now Pacific Data Systems (PDS) to make these timely comments on the Agency Report filed by General Services Agency (GSA) with the Office of Public Accountability (OPA) in this matter on November 5th, 2012.

Upon review of the GSA Agency Report submission to the OPA, it is clear that GSA has chosen not to address the issues defined in the PDS Appeal and appears to have decided to leave the matter up to the OPA for a determination regarding whether the denial of the PDS Protest by GSA should be sustained or overturned as requested by PDS.

It continues to be the position of PDS, as clearly described in our Appeal to the OPA, that the original PDS Protest to GSA should have lead to the rejection of the bid by the group of individual companies referred to in their submission as Teleguam Holdings LLC, GTA Telecom LLC, GTA Services LLC, Pulse Mobile LLC in the GSA IFB GSA-064-11.

At this time, PDS advises the OPA that PDS waives its right to a hearing on this matter and requests that the OPA now render a decision based upon the PDS Appeal filing.
