- A) Purchasing Agency: Guam Department of Education (“GDOE”)
- B) Invitation for Bid No.: Not applicable, insofar as J&B is appealing a Determination and Notice of Suspension (“the Determination”). However, the suspension is related to GDOE Invitation for Bid 050-2011.
- C) The Determination being appealed was made on March 21, 2013 by the head of the purchasing agency. The Determination was received by J&B on March 21, 2013.
- D) Appeal is made from a suspension. This appeal is brought pursuant to 5 GCA §5705.

ORIGINAL

E) Names of competing bidders: Not applicable.

Form and Filing:

1. Notwithstanding J&B's disagreement with the Determination and some of the specific allegations therein, many of the underlying facts are set forth in the Determination and the exhibits thereto. Many of the documents upon which J&B relies are attached as exhibits to the Determination. The Determination is attached hereto as "Exhibit A", and Exhibits to the Determination are referenced below as A-1, A-2, etc. The discussion below focuses on those allegations and conclusions in the Determination with which J&B disagrees.

GDOE awarded J&B a contract for the purchase of air conditioner units. *See* Exhibit A-2 (purchase order). Section 7119(c) of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated provides that any air conditioning system purchased by the Guam Public School System shall "[b]e the subject of a warranty and maintenance agreement that guarantees the system's working life for not less than five (5) years." GDOE violated the statute by awarding separate contracts, to different companies, for the purchase of the units and for the maintenance agreement. *See* Exhibit A (the Determination) at page 2. Thus J&B was put in the position of being asked to provide a warranty for units that it could not maintain, and that a third party was working on.

J&B provided a warranty that stated as follows:

WARRANTY: The equipment shall be guaranteed to be free from defects in materials and workmanship. The warranty period is five (5) years for compressors only from initial start up date or when first DOE school used. Under no circumstances shall supplier and dealer, J&B Modern Tech be liable for incidental or consequential damages resulting without the Preventive Maintenance that should prevent further deterioration, breakdown and inefficient operation and cooling condition of the A/C units. Consumable related to the accessories are not covered. And further more, the warranty is NULL & VOID if damages is caused by Mother Nature or Force Majeure, Thunder & Lightning, Power Fluctuation, Disturbed, Tampered, Adjusted and/or Repaired by other Entities Technicians

Exhibit A-3 (August 27, 2012 letter from J&B to GDOE). GDOE made no objection to this warranty.

Subsequently GDOE contacted to J&B to request that repairs be done on a handful of the units pursuant to the warranty. J&B inspected the units in question and determined that the problems resulted from lack of required maintenance and/or work done on the units by persons other than J&B technicians. J&B noted the extremely dirty condition of the coils. While GDOE has taken the position that the units were less than a year old and thus had not yet required any preventive maintenance whatsoever, anyone who has owned even a window unit air conditioner knows that regular cleaning is necessary. Therefore, J&B took the position that the repairs in question were not covered by the warranty and that the warranty had been voided by the actions of

GDOE and/or third parties. See Exhibits A-5, A-6, A-7, A-8, A-9, A-10, A-11 (correspondence between GDOE and J&B and its counsel concerning the situation, inclusive of photographs in Exhibits A-5 and A-9 documenting the condition of the units.) GDOE responded by suspending J&B for alleged failure to honor the warranty and breach of the terms of the IFB. Exhibit A (the Determination).

GDOE's action is wrongful on both factual and legal grounds. The evidence will establish that the particular problems with the units in question resulted, as J&B asserts, from lack of routine maintenance and/or tampering or repairs done by third parties. As noted above, GDOE wrongfully severed the purchase and maintenance contracts in violation of 17 GCA §7119(c). Separation of the warranty from the maintenance not only violates the statute, but makes no sense. A vendor cannot be expected to warrant maintenance done by his competitor. Anyone who has ever bought a motor vehicle or an appliance knows that the warranty will not remain in effect if one takes the item to the original vendor's competitor for maintenance and repairs.

GDOE's action is also erroneous on procedural grounds. As can be seen from the exchange of correspondence between J&B and GDOE, this dispute was clearly a breach of contract controversy covered by 5 GCA §5427. GDOE never issued a decision complying with that statute. Therefore, it was improper for GDOE to suspend J&B over a breach of contract controversy when GDOE failed to first comply with the statute governing such controversies. After failing to comply with any of the procedures required by 5 GCA §5427, GDOE then also failed to observe due process requirements by providing J&B with a hearing before the suspension. See ATL, Inc. v. United States, 3 Cl. Ct. 259, 274 (1983) (even where government has discretion to debar or suspend, this discretion must be exercised after fair investigation, with such notice, hearing and opportunity to answer as would constitute due process).

Finally, J&B notes the especially suspicious timing of GDOE's action. There is a bid opening scheduled for March 28, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. for Guam Department of Education Invitation for Bid No. 008-2013, Indefinite Quantity Bid for purchase of Air Conditioning Equipment. See Exhibits B (cover page of GDOE IFB 008-2013) and C (deadline for submission). J&B plans to submit a bid for that matter. GDOE threatened action pursuant to 5 GCA §5426 in letters dated November 30, 2012 and February 6, 2013. Exhibits A-6, A-8. If GDOE had taken action on or close to either of those dates, questions concerning the suspension and J&B's status might have been addressed in a timely manner prior to the opening of the bids for GDOE IFB 008-2013. Instead, GDOE waited until March 21, 2013 to issue the Determination, which was not received by J&B until late afternoon on the following day. See Exhibit A at p.3 (received stamp on bottom of page) The Determination provides, "Bids or proposals will not be solicited from J&B, and if they are received, they will not be considered during the period of suspension" GDOE's clear intent was to time the suspension so as to disqualify J&B from bidding IFB 008-2013 while precluding any meaningful opportunity for review of the suspension before the bids are opened.

2. J&B requests that the Office of Public Accountability rule that the suspension was not in accordance with applicable statutes and regulations, that the suspension was not in the best

interests of GDOE, and that the suspension was not fair. J&B requests that the Office of Public Accountability vacate the suspension.

3. Supporting documents are attached hereto as exhibits.

Declaration regarding court action:

J&B confirms that an action in court has not been commenced.

RE: Determination and Notice of Suspension

DETERMINATION

As head of the Purchasing Agency of Guam Department of Education (“GDOE”), I am issuing this determination of probable cause for debarment of J&B Modern Tech (“J&B”).

GDOE awarded the contract for GDOE Invitation for Bid 050-2011 (“IFB”) to J&B. The IFB involved the purchase of air conditioner units for various GDOE schools and support facilities. IFB Section 2.1.2 required that the contractor include a Five (5) Year Warranty for all air conditioner units installed, as required by 17 GCA § 7119. *See Attached Page from IFB 050-2011.* In total, 500 units of various sizes were purchased and installed between January 2012 and July 2012. *See Attached Purchase Order.* At the conclusion of installation, J&B provided a letter to GDOE describing the Warranty as follows:

Warranty: The equipment shall be guaranteed to be free from defects in materials and workmanship. The “Warranty Period” is for five (5) years for Compressor only from the initial start up date or when first DOE school used. Under no circumstances shall supplier and dealer, J&B Modern Tech be liable for incidental or consequential damages resulting without preventative maintenance that should prevent further deterioration, breakdown and inefficient operation and cooling condition of the A/C units. Consumable related to accessories are not covered. And further more, the warranty is NULL & VOID if damages is caused by Mother

Nature or Force Majeure, Thunder & Lightning, Power Fluctuation, Disturbed, Tampered, Adjusted and/or Repaired by other Entities Technicians,

See Attached August 27, 2012, Letter from J&B to GDOE. The total amount of this contract was in excess of \$1.3 million.

In September 2012, pursuant to a separate solicitation, GDOE entered into a contract for repair and preventative maintenance for air conditioners. The contract was competitively bid and J&B submitted a bid. The current repair and maintenance contract was awarded to a company other than J&B that is certified to perform these services.

By January 2013, less than a year after J&B installed the purchased air conditioners, three large units broke down, including a 25 ton HVAC unit, a 36,000 BTU HVAC unit and a 30,000 BTU HVAC unit. GDOE made numerous requests to J&B in order to have these units repaired. *See Attached February 6, 2013, Letter from Marcus Y. Pido to J&B.* J&B has repeatedly refused to repair these units, asserting that the units in question have broken down because persons other than J&B technicians made repairs to these units, and that preventative maintenance was not provided to these units. *See Attached February 11, 2013, Letter from J&B to Marcus Y. Pido.* GDOE has determined that J&B's reasons for not honoring the Warranty have no merit because no persons other than J&B have made any repairs to the units in question and because a lack of preventative maintenance is not a valid reason for the malfunction of the units given the short time period since the units were installed. *See Attached February 13, 2013, Letter from Marcus Y. Pido to J&B.*

By accepting the Purchase Order, J&B agreed to all the terms of the IFB. J&B failed to honor the Warranty and such failure is a breach of the terms of the IFB. J&B has been advised that GDOE may seek J&B's debarment from future procurement involving the purchase and installation of air conditioners. *See Attached February 6 & February 13, 2013, Letters from Marcus Y. Pido to J&B.*

For the reasons above, probable cause exists for the debarment of J&B, more particularly; J&B failed to perform in accordance with the terms of the contract. J&B has been informed that GDOE may seek debarment from future procurements involving air conditioners. As required by 5 G.C.A. § 5426 and 2 G.A.R. Div 4 § 9102, GDOE has consulted with the Attorney General regarding this matter. Therefore, a Notice of Suspension shall be issued, pursuant to 5 G.C.A. § 5426(c) and 2 G.A.R. Div 4 § 9102 (b)(1).

NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

Pursuant to 5 G.C.A. § 5426 and 2 G.A.R. Div 4 § 9102(b)(1), upon determination that probable cause exists for debarment as described above, J&B is hereby notified that it is suspended from consideration for awards of contracts involving air conditioners.

Pursuant to 2 G.A.R. § 9102(b)(1), please be advised of the following:

1. The suspension period is not to exceed three months, pending a complete investigation into possible debarment;

2. Bid or proposals will not be solicited from J&B, and if they are received, they will not be considered during the period of suspension; and
3. Pursuant to 5 G.C.A. § 5426(e), 5 G.C.A. § 5705, 2 G.A.R. Div 4 § 9102(d) and 2 G.A.R Div 4 § 12401 the suspended person may request a hearing.

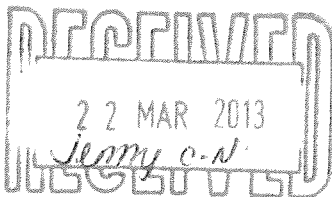

Section 2 – General Information, General Instructions & Project Scope

2.1 – PROJECT TITLE AND OVERALL SCOPE

The Guam Department of Education (GDOE) intends to Purchase Air Conditioning Equipment for All Public Schools and Support Facilities.

2.1.1 – PROJECT/PURCHASE SCOPE

1. Remove and Install all HVAC units recommended by the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) Facilities and Maintenance Division.
2. When the HVAC units are to be replaced, power supply should meet the National Electrical Code (NEC).
3. A five (5) Year Warranty shall be for all HVAC units installed at the Guam Department of Education Public Schools and Support Facilities.
4. Contractor must provide typhoon straps once the units are installed to include condenser/outdoor.
5. Contractor must provide protection of the condenser units that are located on the ground, such as fencing and concrete pad if needed.
6. To include wall brackets as recommended by the Facilities and Maintenance Division. Contractor must provide wall brackets if needed or recommended by the Guam Department of Education, Facilities and Maintenance Division.
7. Prior to replacement of any units, the Contractor must recover refrigerant from units and contractor must certify and record the removal of refrigerant from existing HVAC units.
8. All HVAC units, the Contractor shall remove and transport to the receiving warehouse located in Piti, Guam; Fixed Assets (Property) Section shall be notified of all removal for proper accountability and disposition.
9. For all new HVAC units, installation must include all electrical requirements from main panel box to disconnect switch and to the new HVAC units. (HVAC units must be complete and ready for operation-ready to use.)
10. The Contractor must provide excel list Facilities and Maintenance Division manager where the units are installed and date, to include date semi maintenance. Warranty begins after sign off.
11. Contractor shall provide and installation plan for all new HVAC units that are to be installed.
 - A. Must work with Facilities and Maintenance Division in conjunction with Inventory management Office for an approved plan.
 - B. In the event there is an emergency for any HVAC unit that needs to be installed at GDOE must be approved by Facilities and Maintenance.

Contractor must submit separate cost proposal on any request for replacement of supply and return ducts (to include transition duct and other related works not covered on the original Scope of Work and Guam Department of Education reserves the right to solicit other price quotation/cost proposal from other vendors should Guam Department of Education deems that Contractor's proposal is excessive/high.
13. NOTE: Title 17 Guam Code Annotated (GCA) Education; Chapter 7 Physical Plant. 7119. Standards for air conditioning systems funded herein.

Any HVAC units (Systems) purchased and used by the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) shall:

- A. Meet the comfort and air quality standards set forth for heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) equipment provide in Chapter 5 of the Federal GSA's facilities Standards for Public Buildings Services (Revised November 2000 or Later – PBS-100);

Have repair and replacement parts readily available within five (5) days, excluding weekends and Government of Guam holidays.



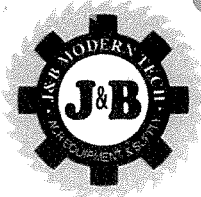

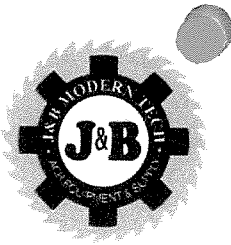

In the November 10, 2012 letter, and received by your end, I noted that I had become aware of 17 GCA §7119, copy enclosed herewith. (c) Be the subject of a warranty and maintenance agreement that guarantees the system's working life for not less than five (5) years."


This statute makes it clear that the warranty and the maintenance agreement are linked. J&B's contract for supply and installation did not include a five year maintenance agreement. If J&B does not have a maintenance agreement for the A/C Units, and is thus unable to ensure proper ongoing maintenance, J&B obviously cannot warrant the A/C units against problems that may arise due to lack of maintenance or someone else's improper maintenance.

Our assessment found out that all the units was so filthy, dirty. Evidently we found out that the 20 tons unit installed at Benevente Middle School evaporator coil was dirty that restrict air passage thru it. If no much heat absorption is taking place, the thermal expansion valve (TXV) will be in closed position. As this happen compressor will continuously running, created high head pressure enough to break pipes joints. And dirty discolored filters, see attachment herewith, causing inefficient operation and cooling condition.

Please let me know DOE's position on this issue. If I have not heard from you by close of business on November 30, 2012, J&B will deem the warranty on the A/C units NULL and VOID for the reasons discussed above.

§ 7101. School Property: Rules and Regulations.

The Board shall adopt rules and regulations for the management and control of school property consistent with government of Guam standard property regulations.

§ 7102. Same: Other Use of.

The Board, upon the written application of any responsible organization or group of at least seven (7) persons, may grant permission to use any school building or school ground as a community or recreation center for the entertainment and education of the People, and for the discussion of all topics tending to the development of personal character and civil welfare; provided, however, that such use shall not seriously infringe upon the necessary uses of the property for school purposes.

The Board shall prescribe such rules and regulations relating to the use of school property as it may deem necessary. The organization or group of persons using the property for the purposes herein authorized shall be responsible for any damage done over and above ordinary wear. Neither the government of Guam nor the Board shall be liable for damage or injury to person or property suffered by any person resulting from a dangerous or defective condition of a school building or school ground while such person is present under permission granted by the Board as authorized herein. The Board may enforce a schedule of charges for the use of such school property, or it may provide such use free of charge, in its discretion, if it deems the use to be sufficiently in the public interest.

§ 7103. Unused School Equipment: Utilization of.

(a) The Board is authorized to enter into agreements with non-public schools for the mutual utilization of school equipment for non-religious purposes which is not being used, or if being used, during periods of non-use.

(b) The Board shall adopt rules and regulations for the mutual utilization of school equipment.

§ 7104. School Facilities; Use of.

The use of school facilities by person(s) or group(s) during non-school hours is hereby authorized.

(a) The Board may grant permission for the use of school facilities, including the gymnasium, theater, staff development center, and other Department facilities located at Tiyan, NAS or Hagatna. The principal, or the principal's designee, shall arrange the scheduling of any non-school activity authorized by the Board and, in addition, serve as liaison between the Board and the requesting party or user group.

(b) The Board, in collaboration with the Superintendent and the various school principals/Tiyan facilities manager/staff development manager, shall prescribe such rules and regulations governing the use of school facilities as it may deem necessary.

(c) The Board is authorized to establish a fee schedule and charge according to such schedule for the use of school facilities.

(d) There are hereby established revolving funds for each public school on a school-by-school basis, to be known as 'I Salappe' Facilitat,' which shall be maintained separate and apart from other funds of the government of Guam and wherein all proceeds generated from user fees collected pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be deposited. Said accounts shall be under the custody and trust of the principal and vice-principal of the respective schools.

The principal and vice-principal may expend such funds for the purpose of off-setting or defraying any added cost(s) incurred by the school as a result of extraordinary community use, or for the purpose of maintaining or improving the school facilities affected by this Act. The fund shall be used to purchase small items and/or services for direct school maintenance or repairs which do not exceed the cost of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per item.

The procurement of items or services costing more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) each shall require authorization of the Superintendent. Each principal shall prepare a quarterly financial status report on the fund to be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board, the Superintendent, and I Liheslaturan Guåhan on or before the end of the quarter of each fiscal year. Additionally, notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Board is authorized to accept donations to '*I Salappe' Facilitat*' on behalf of any school or Department facility.

(e) Person(s) or group(s) using the public school facilities shall be liable for any damage done over and above ordinary wear and tear. Neither the government of Guam nor the Board shall be liable for damage or injury to person or property suffered by any person(s) resulting from a dangerous or defective condition of the school recreational facilities.

(f) Any reservation of the facility may be cancelled, by notice given thirty (30) days in advance, in the event that a school function must be conducted. Said cancellation shall be approved by the school principal.

§ 7105. Authorization of Commercial Advertising Leases.

Within ninety (90) days of the enactment of this Chapter, the Department shall review and revise all existing Department rules and regulations for the management and control of school property in order to authorize the commercial leasing of advertising space at Department and Tiyan sports facilities and on Department of Public Works' school buses, consistent with government of Guam standard property regulations.

Within ninety (90) days of enactment of this Chapter, the Department of Education, in conjunction with the Bus Operations Division of the Department of Public Works, shall develop standard size and placement regulations for the leasing of commercial advertising space at Department and Tiyan sports facilities and on Department of Public Works' school buses. Immediately upon completion, the proposed revisions shall be transmitted to the Board for approval. Within thirty (30) days of receipt, the Board shall adopt the revised rules and regulations with any amendments deemed necessary and appropriate.

§ 7106. Schedule of Commercial Advertising Fees.

Within ninety (90) days of the enactment of this Chapter, the Department of Education shall develop a schedule of fees for the commercial leasing of advertising space at Department of Education and Tiyan sports facilities and Department of Public Works' school buses. Immediately upon completion, the proposed schedule of fees shall be transmitted to the Board for approval. Within thirty (30) days of receipt, the Board shall approve the schedule of fees with any amendments deemed necessary and appropriate.

§ 7107. Standard Lease Agreement for Commercial Advertising.

Within ninety (90) days of the enactment of this Act, the Department of Education shall develop a standard lease agreement for commercial advertising at Department of Education and Tiyan sports facilities and on Department of Public Works' school buses. Such standard lease agreement shall specify the Department's rules and regulations, schedule of fees and legal liabilities for private entities seeking to advertise at Department of Education and Tiyan sports facilities and on Department of Public Works' school buses. Such standard lease agreement shall specifically prohibit any advertising which promotes substances which are controlled by law, or are illegal to distribute to minors, including, without limitation, alcohol; establishments selling primarily alcohol products, such as bars; tobacco products; firearms; obscenity and as may be otherwise determined by the

Board. Immediately upon completion, the proposed standard lease agreement shall be transmitted to the Board for approval. Within thirty (30) days of receipt, the Board shall adopt the standard lease agreement with any amendments deemed necessary and appropriate.

§ 7108. Interscholastic Sports Fund.

There is hereby created, separate and apart from all other funds of the government of Guam, a fund known as the 'Interscholastic Sports Fund' ('Fund') into which shall be deposited all fees collected from the commercial leasing of advertising space at Department of Education and Tiyan sports facilities, and on Department of Public Works' school buses and other monies deemed appropriated by the Department of Education.

(a) Same: Administration. The Fund shall be administered by the Department of Education and shall not be commingled with the General Fund or any other fund of the government of Guam. The Fund shall be maintained in a separate bank account and monies deposited therein shall not be subject to I Maga'láhen Guåhan's transfer authority. The Department of Education is authorized to accept for the Fund gifts, bequests, donations and other kinds of contributions for the purposes of the Fund.

(b) Same: Expenditures. Expenditures from the Fund shall be made exclusively for the purpose of supplementing the costs associated with operating the Department of Education interscholastic sports programs.

The Department of Education may transfer from the Interscholastic Sports Fund to the Department of Public Works such funds as are necessary to fund in whole or in part interscholastic bus transportation.

(c) Same: Distribution of the Interscholastic Sports Fund. Elementary schools may participate in the solicitation of commercial advertising in their respective schools as provided through the Interscholastic Sports Fund Act. However, because the interscholastic sports program exists in the middle and high school levels only, the elementary school that solicits and receives monies for commercial advertising shall deposit all funds into the Interscholastic Sports Fund. The Department of Education shall transfer forty percent (40%) of the total sum of any fees, monetary gifts, donations or contributions collected or derived from the commercial leasing of any part of the facilities for advertising, or other such purposes of an elementary school, into 'I Salappe Facilidat' account of that respective elementary school. The remaining sixty percent (60%) will remain in the Interscholastic Sports Fund to support interscholastic sports programs.

Funds transferred to 'I Salappe Facilitat' accounts of a respective elementary school pursuant to this Subsection shall be expended in accordance with the provisions of 17 GCA §1704, as enacted through Public Law Number 23-67. The distribution of advertising funds for both middle and high schools will be as follows: sixty percent (60%) will remain in the Interscholastic Sports Fund and forty percent (40%) will be retained at the school for its respective sports programs. Any advertising funds collected for the Tiyan Facility or the Staff Development Center (behind George Washington High School in Mangilao) will be distributed as follows: sixty percent (60%) to the Interscholastic Sports Fund and forty percent (40%) for maintenance of those facilities.

(d) Same: Annual Financial Report. Within sixty (60) days after the closing of each fiscal year, the administrator or authorized custodian of the Interscholastic Sports Fund shall transmit to the Board and the Superintendent of the Department of Education an annual report of the expenditures of the Fund, including, but not limited to, a balance sheet, a statement of receipts and expenses, and a general description of the income sources of the Fund and the expenses thereof.

§ 7109. School Property: Unauthorized Entry.

Every person entering any campus maintained by the Department of Education shall immediately proceed to the administrative office of the school located on that campus and announce that person's purpose for being on campus to the principal of that school or the principal's designee. The principal, or the principal's designee, may grant any person written authority to remain on campus for a specific period of time and for a specific purpose, or the principal, or the principal's designee, may order the person to immediately leave the campus. Any person found on a school campus without the written permission provided for in this Section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and is punishable by imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days, or by a fine not exceeding Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or both such fine and imprisonment; provided, that this Section shall not apply to the following:

- (a) students enrolled at the particular school campus who are in good standing and not the subject of an order of suspension or expulsion;
- (b) teachers and staff of the particular school campus;
- (c) peace officers; and

(d) such other persons as the Board by rule or regulation shall permit.

§ 7110. Entry with Intent to Cause Fight.

Every person who at any time enters any school campus maintained by the Department of Education with the intent of entering into a fight with any person or causing disruption on said school campus is guilty of a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

§ 7111. Same: Posting.

The Board shall cause to be posted at the entrance(s) of every school campus, signs which set out in a conspicuous manner §§ 7109 and 7110 of this Chapter. The Board shall see to it that said signs shall continue to be maintained in a readable condition.

§ 7112. Evaluation and Upkeep of Facilities.

(a) The Superintendent of the Department is authorized to enter into one (1) or more contracts with one (1) or more architectural and engineering firms to provide the following services to the Department;

(1) evaluating and reporting on the conditions of Department plant facilities;

(2) preparing architectural and engineering plans for repairs, renovations, improvements, demolition and construction of plant facilities;

(3) assisting in the procurement by the Department, of architectural and engineering services, and construction services, through preparation of requests for proposals and scope of services documents, evaluation of designs, review of construction documents and coordination of compliance of construction documents with all applicable laws, rules and regulations;

(4) performing construction management services for construction projects undertaken; and

(5) providing consultation on prices of architectural and engineering services and construction.

(b) The Superintendent of the Department of Education may solicit requests for proposals and enter into one (1) or more contracts for the procurement of architectural, engineering and construction management

services for the Department, and for construction contracts in excess of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000), one (1) or more contracts for value engineers. Contracts shall be awarded on forms approved by the Attorney General.

(c) Nothing herein shall be construed as exempting the Department from the government of Guam procurement laws as they pertain to the Department.

§ 7112.1. Public-Private Partnership for the Management of the Maintenance, Operation and Repair of GDOE Facilities.

(a) The Guam Department of Education (GDOE) *shall* solicit proposals or bids from qualified parties for the management of the maintenance, operation and repair of GDOE facilities. Such solicitation *shall* be subject to the procurement laws of the government of Guam. The solicitation *shall* include in its scope of work at a minimum, but *not* limited to:

(1) An energy savings performance contract (ESPC) in which the Contractor provides design-build services, inclusive of the acquisition of energy and water efficient fixtures, operations and maintenance services, with guaranteed utility savings which *shall* be used to pay the Contractor.;

(2) Facilities & Maintenance personnel training;

(3) A five (5)-year plan to address and ensure compliance with the Adequate Education Act found in Public Law 28-45 and other applicable public health and safety requirements.

GDOE *shall* issue such solicitation one hundred twenty (120) days after the enactment of this Section.

The procurement process *shall* adhere to the mandates of Public Law 30-157 relative to the duties of the Attorney General. In the event the GDOE finds that it is in its best interests to enter into a contract for the management of the GDOE facilities, the conditions set forth in this § 7112.1 *shall* apply to such contract.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law or regulation, the GDOE may enter into a public-private partnership agreement pursuant to this Section §7112.1 for a period *up to* fifteen (15) years. The initial term of such an agreement *shall* be for a period of *at least* five (5) years.

(c) Initial Investment. The Contractor *shall* be required to purchase

or finance a minimum of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) in equipment acquisition or structural repairs and upgrades of GDOE facilities within one (1) year from the execution of the contract.

(d) Special Terms.

(1) The principal performance manager of the selected Contractor *shall* have a minimum of ten (10) years of experience in managing the operation and maintenance of educational, residential, or food service facilities;

(2) The Contractor must be licensed on Guam to perform the requisite services at the time of contract execution; and

(3) All GDOE Facilities and Maintenance Division employees *shall* continue to be employees of the government of Guam, and subject to the applicable personnel rules and regulations of the GDOE.

(e) Contract Performance Reviews. All contracts awarded subject to the provisions of this Act must contain performance reviews at least annually, and provisions for contract termination *or* penalty based upon such review.

(f) GDOE Maintenance Division employees *shall* have the option to transfer to another line or autonomous agency or department of the government within ninety (90) days of the GDOE contract with a PMC without losing their pay grade, leave, or other benefits, *provided*, that a vacancy exists in the receiving agency and the employee meets the qualification requirements.

“**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall not* take effect until a payment source or a budget for the initial Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) and the amounts required for the remainder of the fifteen (15) year contract period is submitted to and approved by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* (the Guam Legislature).”

§ 7113. Limitations on Capacity Levels for the Construction of New Public Schools.

All public schools built on Guam *shall* be designed and constructed for student enrollment capacity limits as follows:

(a) Elementary Schools: *not to exceed* eight hundred (800)

students;

(b) Middle Schools: *not to exceed* one thousand one hundred twenty (1,120) students; and

(c) High Schools: *not to exceed* one thousand seven hundred (1,700) students.

The school capacity limitations of this Section *shall* apply *only* to school projects initiated after September 30, 1997. The Department may, subject to the approval of the Guam Education Policy Board, *exceed* the capacity limits set forth in this Section provided that such adjustment would *not* endanger student and employee health and safety. These provisions *shall* not apply to school campuses that are temporarily used for double sessions.

§ 7114. Effective Date.

Dear Mr. Bangayan:

I am writing in response to your letters of November 10 and 23, 2012 regarding the warranty for air conditioners purchased by the Guam Department of Education ("GDOE") from your company under GDOE Invitation For Bid ("IFB") 050-2011.

As you know, your company was selected as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the IFB and subsequently received a purchase order authorizing orders under the IFB. Pursuant to Section 2.1.1 of the IFB, a five year warranty was required for all air conditioning units installed at GDOE. On August 27, 2012 you wrote to GDOE Facilities and Maintenance Manager Mr. Billy Cruz advising that you had completed installation of units under the IFB in July and providing the following statement:


WARRANTY: The equipment shall be guaranteed to be free from defects in materials and workmanship. The "Warranty Period" is five (5) years for Compressor only from initial start up date or when first DOE School used. Under no circumstances shall supplier and dealer, J&B Modern Tech be liable for incidental or consequential damages resulting without the Preventive Maintenance that should prevent further deterioration, breakdown and inefficient operation and cooling condition of the A/C units. Consumable related to accessories are not covered. And further more, the warranty is NULL & VOID if damages is caused by Mother Nature or Force Majeure, Thunder & Lightning, Power Fluctuation, Disturbed, Tampered, Adjusted and/or Repaired by other Entities Technicians

Assuming that the statement in your August 27th letter is accepted as a warranty, note that it nullifies the warranty if *damage is caused* by adjustment or repair by entities other than J&B; it does not provide that the warranty is void solely because routine maintenance is performed by another company. Your letters of November 10th and November 23rd are meritless attempts to interpret the warranty in a manner that limits GDOE's ability to competitively secure maintenance and repair services for its air conditioners.

You are hereby advised that GDOE does not accept your interpretation as described in your letters of November 10 and 23, 2012 of the warranty for the air conditioners purchased under IFB 050-2011. You are further advised that should you fail to comply with the terms of the IFB and the warranty specifically provided by you in your letter of August 27, 2012, GDOE may take steps, up to and including legal action, to enforce those terms and to seek whatever damages may be available under such actions.

Also note that failure by your company to perform in accordance with the terms of the IFB will be recorded by GDOE and may be considered in debarment or suspension actions pursuant to 5 GCA §5426.

Dear Mr. Pido:

Thank you for your letter dated November 30, 2012, to Mr. Generoso M. Bangayan of J&B Modern Tech ("J&B") responding to Mr. Bangayan's correspondence about the warranty in connection with IFB 050-2011. J&B has retained my law firm in connection with this matter.

In order to clarify matters, as you state, the warranty provided in Mr. Bangayan's letter of August 27, 2012 does contain an exception if damage is caused by adjustment or repair by someone other than J&B. However, Mr. Bangayan's August 27 letter also stated that J&B shall not be liable for damages resulting from a failure to perform preventive maintenance that would have prevented deterioration, breakdown and inefficient operation and cooling condition of the A/C units.

Furthermore, Section 7119 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated provides in pertinent part, "Any air conditioning system purchased and used by the Guam Public School System shall . . . (c) Be the subject of a warranty and maintenance agreement that guarantees the system's working life for not less than five (5) years." J&B interprets the statute as requiring that the warranty **and** maintenance agreement be part of the original contract for purchase of the system. At the very least, the warranty and maintenance agreement are linked by the statute. The statute was not followed with respect to IFB 050-2011. Obviously, a vendor cannot warrant against damages that result from lack of maintenance, or improper maintenance and repairs by other

parties. Similarly, once someone other than J&B opens a unit and works on it, it becomes difficult if not impossible to tell if any particular problem was caused by the technician from the other entity. As a logical and practical matter, the condition of the units becomes the responsibility of the person or entity who works on the units or tampers with them. It is for this reason that J&B cannot warrant the units if someone else works on them.

Notwithstanding that DOE appears to have violated 17 GCA §7119 by not including maintenance in the original contract for the A/C units, now that the contract for purchase and installation of the A/C units is complete and a separate maintenance contract has been awarded, the past cannot be undone. In raising issues relating to the warranty, J&B does not seek to challenge the award of the maintenance contract to another company. However, now that someone other than J&B has control over the units, J&B cannot warrant that other party's work. The maintenance and the warranty should be linked, as they are in 17 GCA §7119(c), with the entity that provides the maintenance also providing the warranty.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. Please let me know if the Guam Department of Education has further concerns about either J&B's position or about any specific problem with the A/C units.

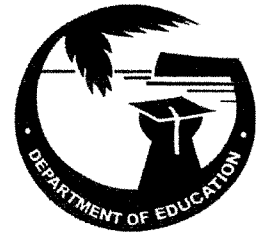

Dear Mr. Bangayan,

Hafa Adai! I am writing in regards to the warranty for air conditioners purchased by the Department of Education ("GDOE") from your company J&B Modern Tech ("J&B") under GDOE Invitation For Bid ("IFB") 050-2011.

Over the last several weeks, GDOE has requested repairs be made to the following air conditioners:

1. a 25 Ton HVAC unit at Southern High School located in Building 3000,
2. a 36,000 BTU HVAC unit at Agueda I. Johnston Middle School located in the Main office and
3. a 30,000 BTU HVAC unit located in G-8 A at H.B Price Elementary School.

Each of these units was purchased pursuant to the IFB. Section 2.1.2 of the IFB explicitly required a Five (5) Year Warranty ("Warranty") for all HVAC units installed by J&B, and by accepting the purchase order for this IFB, J&B has agreed to honor the Warranty. J&B has also acknowledged the Warranty in its letter to GDOE of August 27, 2012.

J&B has asserted that the units in question have broken down because (1) persons other than J&B technicians made repairs to these units, and (2) preventative maintenance was not provided to these units. To be clear, no persons other than J&B have made repairs to these units. In addition, these units were purchased less than a year ago, so claims that preventative maintenance has not been provided are unfounded. Therefore, J&B is bound by the Warranty to provide repairs on the units in question.

GDOE has repeatedly requested that J&B make repairs to these units it has installed, as evidenced in attached emails. GDOE hereby demands that J&B honor its Warranty and repair the units within three days. Failure to do so will be considered a breach of the Warranty and the terms of the IFB. Such breach may be considered for action pursuant to 5 G.C.A. § 5426. Additionally, GDOE may pursue any remedies available by law, including recovery from your company for any costs incurred by GDOE for repairing the units.



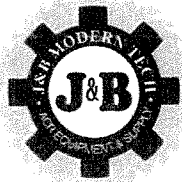

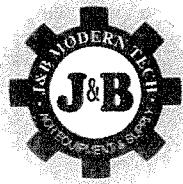

Section 2.1.2 of the IFB explicitly required a Five (5) Year Warranty ("Warranty") for all HVAC units installed by J&B, and by accepting the purchase order for this IFB, J&B has agreed to honor the warranty. J&B has also acknowledged the Warranty in its letter to GDOE of August 27, 2012.

RESPONSE:

Following is an extract from my letter on behalf of J&B dated August 27, 2012, with boldface and underlining added to emphasize key phrases:

WARRANTY: The equipment shall be guaranteed to be free from defects in materials and workmanship. The warranty period is five (5) years for compressors only from initial start up date or when first DOE school used. Under no circumstances shall supplier and dealer, J&B Modern Tech be liable for incidental or consequential damages resulting without the Preventive Maintenance that should prevent further deterioration, breakdown and inefficient operation and cooling condition of the A/C units. Consumable related to the accessories are not covered. And further more, the warranty is NULL & VOID if damages is caused by Mother Nature or Force Majeure, Thunder & Lightning, Power Fluctuation, Disturbed, Tampered, Adjusted and/or Repaired by other Entities Technicians.

Please note the language underlined above.

Furthermore, 17 GCA §7119 provides in pertinent part, “[A]ny air conditioning system purchased and used by the Guam Public School System shall . . . (c) be the subject of a **warranty and maintenance agreement** that guarantees the system’s working life for not less than five (5) years.”

Over the last several weeks, GDOE has requested repairs be made to the following air conditioners:

1. *a 25 Ton HVAC unit at Southern High School located in Building 3000,*
2. *a 36,000 BTU HVAC unit at Agueda I. Johnston Middle School located in the Main Office and*
3. *a 30,000 BTU HVAC unit located in G-8 A at H.B. Price Elementary School.*

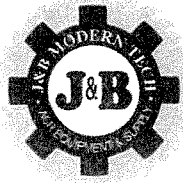
J&B has asserted that the units in question have broken down because (1) person other than J&B technicians made repairs to these units, and (2) preventative maintenance was not provided to these units. To be clear, no persons other than J&B have made repairs to these units. In addition, these units were purchased less than a year ago, so claims that preventative maintenance has not been provided are unfounded. Therefore, J&B is bound by the Warranty to provide repairs on the units in question.

RESPONSE:

Before we received the call from GDOE to check the 25 ton HVAC unit at Southern High School in Building 3000, a very reliable informant relayed to us that a certain CIP supervisor asked somebody to go and temporarily fix the unit in building 3000 but instead he ignored the request. I can’t reveal the informant’s name for reasons of his job or employment security, but if a worst case scenario comes to pass he is willing to engage in a dialogue with you before the superintendent.

Then, J&B received the CIP request to check the A/C problem in building 3000. The first time J&B had access to the problem, J&B’s technician found out that the unit was jumpered. The technician removed the jumper and proceeded to fix the unit.

As regards J&B’s position that preventative maintenance was not provided to these units, during its assessment on all A/C units installed at Southern High School J&B found filthy, dirty, clogging coils causing the inefficient cooling and operation. Please see the attachment. There should be a complete service maintenance that will prevent further deterioration and breakdown not only at Southern High School but to all school units installed under GDOE IFB-050-2011.

GDOE has repeatedly requested that J&B make repairs to these units it has installed, as evidenced in attached emails. GDOE hereby demands that J&B honor its Warranty and repair the units within three days. Failure to do so will be considered a breach of the Warranty and the terms of the IFB. Such breach may be considered for action pursuant to 5 G.C.A. §5426. Additionally, GDOE may pursue any remedies available by law, including recovery from your company for any costs incurred by GDOE for repairing the units.

J&B's stand remains the same despite your repeated threats under 5 GCA §5426 concerning debarment or suspension of a contractor. J&B's position remains that the warranty is null and void. J&B's decision is based on our assessment, proof attached to prior correspondence relating to lack of maintenance, and the fact that maintenance and the warranty must be linked, as they are in 17 GCA §7119.

J&B would not void the warranty if only GDOE did not neglect to maintain all the A/C units installed at schools in par condition. Service maintenance should be completely and properly done, included cleaning and flushing and checking the voltage, refrigerant, amperage, thermostat setting, vibrate motors and bearing and compressor oil levels, etc. Unfortunately, GCOE appears to have violated 17 GCA §7119. In addition, it appears no service maintenance was ever done, causing all of the units installed to be in very poor condition. That is why J&B has voided the warranty.

Today the condition of all of the units installed is that they all need to have service maintenance. J&B is still open for negotiation on service maintenance and to reinstate a warranty for 5 years on the compressor only.

Thank you for your attention to these matters. I look forward to hearing from you.

Dear Mr. Bangayan,

Hafa Adai! I am writing in response to your letter received on February 11, 2013, regarding the warranty for air conditioners purchased by the Guam Department of Education ("GDOE") from your company J&B Modern Tech's ("J&B") under GDOE Invitation For Bid 050-2011 ("IFB").

J&B's reasons for voiding the Five (5) Year Warranty ("Warranty") for all HVAC units installed pursuant to the IFB are unacceptable. The terms of the Warranty explicitly state that it will be null and void if *damage is caused* by adjustment or repair by entities other than J&B. The Warranty does not provide that it is void solely because another company performs routine maintenance. J&B's interpretation is nonsensical. You claim that the Warranty is voided if no preventative maintenance is performed. Then you claim that if preventative maintenance is performed by certified technicians other than J&B, the Warranty is also voided. GDOE does not agree with J&B's interpretation of the Warranty. GDOE continues to maintain (1) no other person has made any repairs to any of the units J&B has installed pursuant to the IFB, and (2) the lack of preventative maintenance was not the cause of the units breaking down. GDOE also notes that J&B has provided air conditioner units that have broken down less than one year after installation, indicating those units were faulty to begin with.

J&B continues to refuse to honor the Warranty and make the required repairs to the air conditioner units referenced in my February 6, 2013, letter. By accepting the Purchase Order, J&B agreed to all the terms in the IFB – which includes the requirement of the Warranty (Section 2.1.1). GDOE considers this refusal to honor the Warranty as a breach of the terms of the IFB. You are hereby notified that due to your refusal to repair the air conditioner units, GDOE has no alternative but to proceed in acquiring the necessary repairs to the air conditioning units. GDOE intends to pursue any and all remedies available by law to recover the costs associated in procuring repairs to the referenced air conditioner units and any future air conditioner units J&B refuses to repair pursuant to the Warranty and the IFB.

Finally, in your letter, you stated J&B is open to negotiate a service maintenance contract, and after this contract is in place, J&B will reinstate the Warranty. GDOE views this offer as an attempt to procure a maintenance contract outside of the procurement rules and regulations. GDOE will not engage in any discussions that violates the provisions of the Guam Procurement Law.

My client J&B Modern Tech has asked me to respond to your letter to J&B dated February 13, 2013. Thank you for your response to J&B's letter. Please be advised that J&B continues to stand by its position concerning the warranty for air conditioning units purchased under GDOE IFB-050-2011.

I will not repeat matters already set forth at length in J&B's prior correspondence. However, it should be noted that J&B is somewhat surprised by the Department of Education's apparent change of position concerning warranties. In September of 2011, J&B sent the Department a Freedom of Information request asking for a list of air conditioning units acquired under IFB-044-2011 and IFB-050-2011 that were under warranty. A copy of the request and DOE's response are enclosed. Very few units were still under warranty, presumably because DOE had recognized that a warranty could not be enforced under situations, such as that involved in the current dispute, where DOE did not provide for the warrantor to provide ongoing maintenance as contemplated in 17 GCA §7119.

J&B was also involved in a similar situation in 2009, when a chiller unit at Simon Sanchez was found to be in a condition very much like that of the air conditioning units now at issue. J&B took the position that a warranty for a chiller unit at Simon Sanchez School did not cover problems caused by lack of maintenance and/or alterations by other persons. A copy of J&B's letter of January 7, 2009 concerning that matter is enclosed. DOE did not contest J&B's position at that time.

In conclusion, J&B respectfully stands by its position that the problems with the air conditioners now at issue stem from failure to perform preventive maintenance and from work done on the units by other persons. As such, these problems are outside the scope of any warranty.

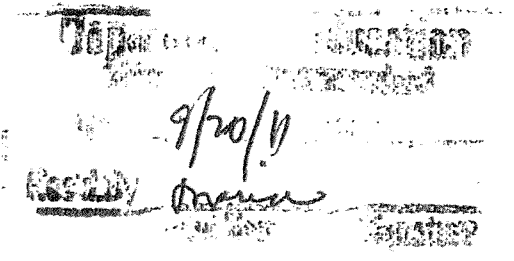



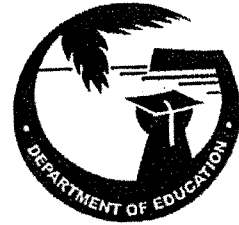

Due to the outcome of the **MANDATORY PRE-BID** held on Monday, March 11, 2013 the following is the Clarification:

1. Upon receipt of the notice to proceed, the successful bidder has 210 calendar days to complete the project as specified in IFB 008-2013. All a/c units must be installed and operational on or before the specified 210 day timeline.
2. In IFB 008-2013, The Buy America Act requirement will stand for the purchase and installation of A/C units 5 tons and above. Hence, the Buy America Act will not be required for the purchase and installation of A/C units 36,000 BTU and below.
3. The condenser section for all A/C units specified in this IFB, requires that coils shall be configured with aluminum or copper finned surface mechanically bonded to seamless copper tubing coil as specified on page 44, 9.0.
4. The successful bidder is required to install concrete pads for units installed (as needed) and stipulated in **Item #6 on Page 3 of Clarification #2**.
5. Acceptable alternative coatings for the evaporator and condenser coils are Acrylic coated gold fins or Luvata Electro fin E Coatings. The GDoE requires a factory certificate for the application of the required coating.
