

1 Friday, August 8, 2008 at 11:00 a.m. For the benefit of the parties and their counsel, the Hearing  
2 Officer issues the following statement regarding the scheduled Pre-Hearing conference:

3 The Pre-Hearing Conference will focus on expediting the disposition of the appeal and  
4 may include:

- 5 a) Formulation and simplification of issues;
- 6 b) Possibility of obtaining admissions of fact and of documents that will avoid  
7 unnecessary proof, stipulations regarding the authenticity of documents, and advance rulings  
8 from the Hearing Officer on the admissibility of evidence;
- 9 c) The avoidance of unnecessary proof and of cumulative evidence;
- 10 d) The identification of witnesses and documents, the need and schedule for filing and  
11 exchanging pretrial briefs;
- 12 e) The disposition of pending motions;
- 13 f) The need for adopting special procedures for managing potentially difficult or  
14 protracted actions, complex issues, multiple parties, or unusual proof problems;
- 15 g) Establishing a reasonable limit on the time allowed for presenting evidence; and
- 16 h) Such other matters as may facilitate the just, speedy, and inexpensive disposition of  
17 the action.
