i. Appeal Information

The Guam Economic Development Authority Agrees that it is the purchasing Agency. GEDA agrees that there was a contract entered into between itself and the Appellant to construct the Farmers' Cooperative Association of Guam Facility and Relocation of the Dededo Flea Market. GEDA agrees that the Appellant states it appeals an Agency decision made 10 April 2017. GEDA denies Appellant received that decision on 17 April 2017 but that it did receive it on 13 April 2017. GEDA denies that this Appeal excludes claims of money owed to or by the government and states that this Appeal is entirely about a claim for money allegedly owed by the government. See Appeal and Procurement Record at pp. 491 et seq. Names of competing bidders are contained at Procurement Record p. 447 but please be aware that this is not an appeal of a protest of a solicitation or award.

ii. Form and Filing

GEDA agrees that the Governor of Guam approved the above referenced contract. GEDA asserts that the contract and the contract documents speak for themselves. GEDA notes that Appellant neither states nor establishes that it met the requirements of Paragraphs 10 and 12 of Section 0700, General Conditions, of the contract. Accordingly, Appellants claim for compensation is barred. *See Notice of Appeal*,

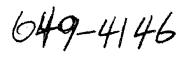

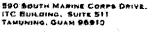

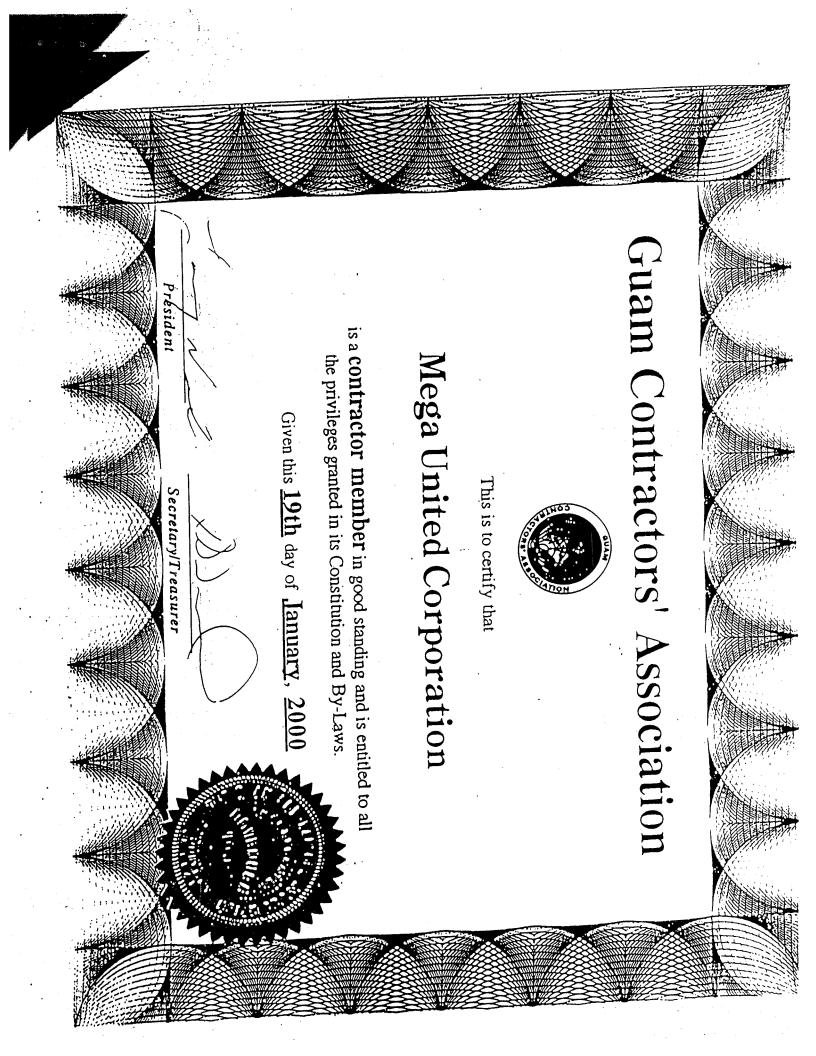
