COMES NOW the Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) and Opposes a Motion

Finally, JJ Global asks to subpoena certain witnesses. This need not be the subject of a motion, it may of course do so as part of the merits hearing. JJ Global may have meant to ask for the ability to depose certain individuals. The Agency has no objection to this but will itself request subpoenas and notices for deposition to issue to Mr. Louis Bustamante and Ms. Rose Meno. The Agency believes these two (the owner and an employee of JJ Global respectively) have knowledge of a criminal fraud perpetrated upon GVB as well as this Office.
